Recipe of the Month: Groundhog Chili

Ingredients:

- 1 Tablespoon olive oil
- 1 onions, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 (14.5 ounce) cans chicken broth
- 1 (4 ounce) can green Chile peppers, chopped
- 1 Teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 Teaspoon dried oregano
- 3/4 Teaspoon cayenne pepper (reduce to your taste)
- 2 1/2 3 cups cooked groundhog (or chicken breast), chopped
- 2 (14.5 ounce) cans Cannellini beans or Great Northern Beans
- 1/2 Cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Heat oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add the onions and garlic and sauté for 10 minutes, or until onions are tender. Add the broth, green Chile peppers, cumin, oregano, and cayenne pepper and bring to a boil. Simmer for 30 minute, covered.
- 2. Add the meat and beans and return pot to a simmer. Simmer for 20 to 30 minutes. Pour into bowls and top with cheese. Enjoy!
