



Airstream Club International Rally2023 Get Ready Guide

Dear Members,

We are excited to invite you to the upcoming Airstream Rally in Wyoming, which will be held from June 24-30, 2023, at the Sweetwater Events Complex in Rock Springs, WY. This event promises to be an exciting and memorable experience for all those who attend, and we cannot wait to welcome you to the beautiful state of Wyoming.

To ensure that your time at the rally is enjoyable and stress-free, we would like to provide you with some important information regarding the event.

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Registration:

All attendees must register prior to the event. The registration fee includes camping, access to all activities and one rally welcome meal. Please ensure that you have registered for the arrival date of your choice, June 21 through June 24.

Camping:

The camping area is located at <u>Sweetwater Events Complex</u>, and all attendees will be provided with a designated spot for their Airstream. Hookups will be available for your convenience, including water, sewer and electric. Generators are not needed, with the exception of the designated boondocking generator area, and then will only be allowed during designated hours.

Activities:

We have a full schedule of activities planned for the event, including exhibitors, seminars, tours, meals and social events. We encourage all attendees to participate in these activities, as they are a great opportunity to connect with other Airstream enthusiasts.

First-timers:

If this is your first Airstream Rally, welcome! We want to make sure you feel comfortable and at home during your stay. We encourage you to reach out to fellow Airstreamers and event organizers if you have any questions or need any assistance. Additionally, we will have a welcome session specifically for first-timers, where you can learn more about the rally and get to know your fellow attendees.

Important reminder:

Please bring extra sewer hoses, water hoses, and electrical cables to ensure that you have enough to last the duration of the rally. We recommend bringing at least 20-30 feet of each, as the distance between your Airstream and the hookups may vary.

Golf carts:

Members have the option to rent a private golf cart for use during the event. Alternatively, you may also bring your own golf cart to use during the rally. The form to rent a golf cart can be found on our rally website at airstreamclub.org/rally2023

Big Red Numbers:

We encourage all attendees to bring and display their membership Big Red Numbers. With more than 1300 Airstreams in attendance, displaying your Big Red Numbers makes it easier for fellow attendees and Rally Services to locate you.

Additional information:

We also recommend that you read the FAQs section on the <u>airstreamclub.org/Rally2023</u> website for any additional information regarding the event. This section will provide you with useful information such as check-in times, directions to the site, and what to expect during the event.

Arrival Checklist:

- Check your Airstream for any maintenance or repair needs prior to departure.
- Pack all necessary items, such as bedding, towels, toiletries, cooking supplies and clothing.
- Bring any outdoor gear that you may need for the activities planned, such as hiking shoes, binoculars and sunscreen.
- Make sure you have all the necessary hookups, including sewer hoses, water hoses and electrical cables.
- Familiarize yourself with the route to the campsite and plan for any stops or breaks you may need.
- Check the weather forecast and pack accordingly.
- Bring any necessary medications or medical equipment.

- If you plan to use a golf cart during the event, either bring your own or consider renting a private golf cart.
- Bring your Club Name Badge.
- Don't forget to bring and display your membership Big Red Numbers.

General:

Q: This is my first time attending an international rally. What can I expect?

A: We've created a special fact sheet just for you! Click here for lots of information to help you navigate the rally and answer all your questions.

Q: Who do I contact regarding planning a caravan to the Rally?

A: Caravan Arrivals are scheduled by Club Headquarters. If you are planning to arrive at the same time in a group of five (5) or more Airstreams to the Rally to be parked together, we define this as a Caravan Arrival, and pre-arrangements are necessary for our parking crew to get things organized for a smooth ingress. Please contact Barb at rally@airstreamclub.org to schedule a Caravan Arrival date.

Q: How can I sign up to present a seminar at the rally?

A: Email comments@airstreamclub.org if you have questions.

Registration

Q: How do we register for the International Rally?

A1: To register for boondocking, click here.

A2: To register for the rally if camping off site, click <u>here</u>.

Q: May we attend the entire rally without having our Airstream parked on site?

A: Yes, you may register for the rally without paying any camping fee. The rally fee is \$125 per adult and \$75 per youth (13 yrs - 17 yrs). Children (4 yrs -12 yrs): \$40. Children 3 and under are free. Day passes can be purchased from the Cashier at the Welcome Area at the rally.

Q: What is a Day Pass and where do I purchase one?

A: Day passes can be purchased from the Cashier who will be at Welcome during General Parking and then at Member Services for the remainder of the rally. All Day Passes are non-refundable.

Guests - A member who has paid to attend the Rally may arrange for their guest(s), who is not a member or is a past member of ACI to receive a daily guest pass. These passes will be valid for one (1) day.

Guest Day Pass Prices:

Adults (18 & over) = \$25.00 each per day

- Youth (13-17) = \$15.00 each per day
- Child (4-12) = \$10.00
- Child (3 & under) = Free if accompanied by a paying adult

Members - A member who hasn't paid to attend the Rally may purchase a Day Pass to attend events at the Rally. These passes are valid for one (1) day. Prices are the same as Guest Day Pass.

Day Pass attendees (members or guests) may attend all events except meals on the calendar day they have paid for. They are not entitled to any complimentary promotional items or meals.

Q: What is the difference between an Off-site registration and a Day Pass?

A: Members who wish to stay in a hotel or at a nearby campground are considered "Off-site" registrations. They pay the rally fee (described above) and attend the whole rally with the same privileges as members staying on-site in their campers. Day passes are for a specific day and allow the member or guest to attend all activities for that day but does not include any meals, gifts, pins, etc. See link above to register off-site. Day passes can be purchased from the Cashier at the Welcome Area at the rally.

Q: Will being an International, Region or Club Officer give me a priority with registration?

A: No. All registrations are processed on a first come, first served basis.

Q: Do Rally Committee Chairs or volunteers get priority with registration?

A: No. All registrations are processed on a first come, first served basis.

Q: We're traveling together in one Airstream but have two membership numbers (Big Red Numbers, "BRNs"). Are we eligible for two entries in the drawings (must be present to win: Tuesday; main stage; 9a-10a) and two lifetime member registration discounts?

A: Yes, one person should register with an RV on site plus one adult, and the other as no RV on site and one adult.

Q: What if something comes up and I need to cancel my registration?

A: Refund requests should be emailed to rally@airstreamclub.org or by calling HQ at 937-596-5211. Requests received on or before April 28, 2023 will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests on or after April 29, 2023, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after June 10, 2023. If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance: Travel MedEvac Trip Insurance.

Q: What are the facilities at Rock Springs?

A: Hookups are 50amp electric, water and sewer. The Sweetwater Events Complex is a beautiful, well-maintained facility. All campsites are back-in sites and the majority of them will be on gravel. They also have restrooms on-site and showers.

Q: Can I rent a golf cart or bring my own?

A: Yes and yes. Golf Cart rental is for one week only - From Saturday, June 24, and must be returned to the corral on Friday, June 30. Only weekly rentals are available. Only licensed drivers over the age of 16 are allowed to drive. Renters will be responsible for any damage done to the cart and charged accordingly. Renters will be responsible for refueling their own carts. There is a gas station next to the Sweetwater Event Center. Renters are welcome to share a cart with a fellow member, but you are responsible for exchanging monies for the rental. If you rent a cart and cancel before May 31, you will receive a full refund. NO CANCELLATIONS or refunds on June 1 or after. Click here to rent a golf cart.

Q: Can I bring my side-by-side?

A: Yes. The city requires that they be licensed (from any state) and have the plate mounted and visible. Side-by-sides are also allowed on the area roadways with a valid registration and license plate.

Q: Cellular service: How good is it?

A: Verizon is very good, both for voice and data, across the whole facility and with heavy load. The other carriers (AT&T and TMobile) are reported to not perform well with lots of people on site.

Q: WiFi: Does free WiFi exist, and where?

A: Strong WiFi exists in the main buildings but not in the general parking/camping areas.

Q: Are we allowed to have campfires?

A: <u>UPDATED CAMPFIRE POLICY:</u> You are welcome to have a fire at your campsite, as long as it's contained in a metal ring. A screen is recommended to contain embers from catching in the wind. Campsites do not have fire rings or picnic tables.

Q: Are public restrooms/showers available?

A: Yes. Each campground has a restroom/shower facility, plus there are restrooms/showers in the Sweetwater Events Complex' Indoor Arena.

Q: Can I send mail or a package to the facility?

A: The mailing and shipping address is: Sweetwater Events Complex, Attn: Airstream Rally c/o: FirstName LastName, BRN ##### 3320 Yellowstone Road, Rock Springs, WY 82901. Mail and packages should be scheduled to arrive no earlier than June 22.

Q: I need to receive an Amazon package. Where is the nearest "Amazon Locker"?

A: With Amazon Hub Locker, you can receive your Amazon packages at secure locations. Locker locations can be found when selecting a shipping address during the checkout process.

Q: Is there a hotel available in the area that offers a discounted group rate?

A: Group blocks are on hold at any of the following three hotels. Please call to make your reservations:

<u>Holiday Inn Rock Springs</u> - Daily rate is \$90.00; pet-friendly rooms available for \$119 per day. Old Chicago - Restaurant on site. Breakfast not included but a \$5 coupon included that can be used at the restaurant. Indoor pool and gym on site. Airport shuttle provided. Call (307) 382-9200 and ask for "Airstream Rally".

My Place Hotel - Daily rate is \$100; pets allowed, up charge is \$15/day. Kitchenette with full-sized refrigerator, two burner cooktop, coffee maker and a microwave. Laundry on site. No airport shuttle. Call (307) 362-5977and give them the code "AIRSTRMCLUB". Rate available from 06/15/23 - 07/06/23. Additional taxes apply.

<u>Comfort Inn and Suites</u> - Daily rate for double room is \$115; king is \$120. Pets are not allowed. Free breakfast. Indoor pool and hot tub. Guest laundry. No airport shuttle. Call (307) 362-9100 and ask for "Airstream Group".

Q: KOA Information

KOA – Rock Springs/Green River, 86 Foothill Blvd, Rock Springs, WY 82901, Call 307-362-3063 for reservations. The KOA currently has 50 amp and 30 amp full hook sites available. Parking / Arrival

Q: When will Rally parking begin?

A: General parking is June 24. You may select an earlier parking arrival date when registering. If you decide not to register for an arrival date earlier than June 24, but change your mind: no problem, just click this link https://form.jotform.com/223257545189161 to add and process payment for additional days securely online, or call headquarters at 937-596-5211 and ask for a change.

Q: I am looking for a place to meet up with my caravan or friends somewhere in Rock Springs. What do you recommend?

A: If you need to wait on your friends somewhere so you can all enter the rally together, we recommend heading to the optional "staging" area just across the street from Sweetwater Events Complex. It's a large parking lot called the Yellowstone Arena Lot that can accommodate many Airstreams. No utilities (no water, sewer or electrical) are available in this area. Simply follow directions to the Sweetwater Events Complex, taking Yellowstone Road NORTH, then turn WEST onto Armory Drive (see map). The GPS location is 41.6371, -109.251 (41°38'13.7"N 109°15'05.5"W). You'll be able to temporarily gather there, then look for the Welcome Signs directing you into the rally when you're ready.

Q: Can I park with my buddy?

A: The parking team will make every effort to park you with your friends, but you must arrive together. Please review the following information that will help us help you park with a group:

- Please plan to meet offsite and caravan to the grounds together (see above).
- Groups of five or more should register as a caravan by emailing rally@airstreamclub.org by May 10, 2023 (deadline extended from May 1). If you are not registered with a caravan leader, we will not have the ability to pre-plan space for you to park in the same area.
- If you are planning a caravan, everyone on that caravan needs to be registered to arrive the same day.
- If you are planning to parking with any of the following groups, be sure to select that group when you register: ADA, Band and all Intra-Clubs.

In short, as amazing and extraordinary as our volunteer parking crew is, we likely will not be able to accommodate requests for special parking at the time of your arrival if you haven't made arrangements per the above guidelines. **Due to this being a sold-out rally, we will not be able to re-locate you to a different campsite after you have been parked.**

Q: How does Intra-club group parking differ from Caravan parking?

A: Caravan parking is defined as five or more Airstreams in an organized caravan with a designated caravan leader. All caravan members arrive at the rally at the same time (you can use the Caravan Staging Area to help you get lined up and wait for any stragglers), on a date that has been arranged through the caravan leader.

Intra-club group parking is defined as a list of registered attendees that will all be parking in the same area together. Intra-clubs are given this privilege because their members are from all over North America and they contribute in planning activities for all rally attendees. They may be members of the Intra-club or just interested in finding out more about the club. Group members can arrive on different dates, as a specific number of campsites have been reserved for the group based on the sign ups.

The deadline to sign up for caravan and Intra-club parking is May 10, 2023: no exceptions. Contact your caravan or intra-club leader to assure you are on their parking list, or if you aren't sure who to contact, email rally@airstreamclub.org or call 937-596-5211.

Q: Can I move my campsite location after it has been assigned to me when I arrive?

A: No. Due to this being a sold-out rally, it will not be possible to relocate your campsite to another spot once you have been parked upon arrival.

Q: What do I do if I arrive after hours?

A: If you come to the rally after hours (parking closes by 6 p.m.), follow the signs to the parking staging area, park and dry camp overnight. Do not unhitch, as you will be parked as soon as the parking attendants return the next morning. Please be ready to park when our parking attendants arrive at 8 a.m.

Q: For members staying offsite, will my vehicle that I drive to and from the rally be able to park close to the activities?

A: Yes, parking will be available.

Q: For members staying offsite, how do I check in?

A: The first time you enter the rally grounds, please enter using the Arrival Entrance (see map) and proceed to the Check-In area. The Rally Arrival Team will welcome you to the rally, give you your Welcome bag, programs, etc. and direct you to the vehicle parking area.

Q. Do we need to bring extra hoses, power cords, and adapters?

A: Yes. Please bring two 25-ft water hoses or longer (usually white or blue), as the utilities are behind the campsites. Bring an additional electric cord and a 50-to-30 amp adapter if your trailer is 30 amp. All sites in Rock Springs are 50 amp.

Some more information:

- We realize the desire to keep additional equipment and costs at a minimum.
- Please understand that the 1,200 RV sites have significant differences, causing distances to utilities to vary, mainly based on their construction date.
- In addition, the length of our Airstreams also varies significantly, from a 20' Basecamp to a 33' Classic. Complicating matters is the varying placement of the utility connections on our Airstreams: some are in front of the tires, and some are behind.
- The guidance above should ensure a successful initial connection to the Sweetwater Events full hookups; regardless of which site, the specifics of your Airstream, and where you park your Airstream.

Additional suggestions:

- While not necessary for roughly two-thirds of the sites, some configurations and differences between Airstreams may require 30' of sewer hose. Perhaps even 40' for exceptionally long trailers. We recommend the typical factory length of 20', but given the relatively inexpensive cost, we suggest a) bringing up to 30' 40' of sewer, b) being prepared to order additional from Amazon or b) seeing if you can purchase locally if needed.
- Consider keeping your receipt and leaving the "tags" on the expensive electrical cables. If you don't need it, you can easily return it.

Q: Will the Interstates and Atlas units be parked in their own area, or dispersed throughout the facility?

A: Interstates and Atlas units are parked based on arrival time and will be parked amongst the rest of the Airstreams, not in a separate area.

Q: Will Interstates and Atlas members be able to move their rigs in and out of the area, as others can move their tow vehicles? So we can go shopping, empty tanks, etc?

A: Yes, you will be able to move in and out of the parking spots.

Exhibitors:

Q: Will exhibitors be at the rally?

A: Yes, the Exhibit Hall will be open each day of the rally. To see a list of exhibitors coming or to sign up as an exhibitor, click here. Visit the Exhibit Hall daily, as there will be new pop-up vendors each day!

Volunteering:

Q: How can I volunteer for a committee?

A: Committees seeking volunteers will post their needs in the Blue Beret in upcoming months. You can also email your interest in volunteering to rally@airstreamclub.org. Or, click here to view the form to fill out to add yourself to the volunteer list now!

Children:

Q: Are there activities for the children?

A: The rally will have activities planned for youth and children. The cost is included in their rally fee.

Pets:

Q: Can we bring our pets?

A: Yes, please make plans to bring your furry friends per the following On-Grounds Pet Policy: All pets must be on a 6-foot, non-retractable leash when outside the Airstream. Always check collars and leashes to make sure they fit correctly and are working properly. A size appropriate pet containment system can be used at the campsite. Pets are not permitted in the buildings or outside dining areas during a meal with the exception of working service animals. During severe weather, pets may be taken into the designated shelters. Well mannered dogs are welcome to play and exercise in designated dog parks. Always clean up after your pet. And, make sure your pet has an ID tag.

First Timers 101

Welcome to your very first Airstream Club International Rally! You're in for an incredibly funfilled week. With so many activities to choose from, it's easy to get overwhelmed and possibly miss something you really want to attend. We'd like you to arrive well informed on what to expect so you'll get the most out of your rally experience. The following topics give you an idea of what to expect at the rally.

What is a First Timer?

A First Timer is someone who is attending the International Rally for the first time. First Timers may be totally new to the club or have been in the club for many years but never attended the international rally. Either way, we're happy you're here!

Registering for the International Rally:

You can register for the rally on-line by logging into the club website and then going to airstreamclub.org/Rally2023/acirally2023-registration. There's a button to click to print a paper registration form if you want to mail a check. Or you can also call HQ at (937) 596-5211 and register with a credit card. If you decide not to register for an arrival date earlier than June 24, but change your mind: no problem, just click this link https://form.jotform.com/222233940034142 to add and process payment securely online, or call headquarters at 937-596-5211 and ask for a change.

Since you are choosing your arrival date, it's not important whether you register earlier or later. However, our international rallies are becoming more popular and there are a fixed number of campsites at the venue, so registering early guarantees you a site.

What to expect when you arrive:

When you arrive at the Check In area, the Rally Arrival Team will greet you. At Check In, we'll provide you with your Welcome Bag and rally programs. The Welcome Bag will contain your rally ribbons, First Timer ribbons, coupons, meal tickets and more. A Rally Arrival Team member will guide you to your parking site and help get you safely parked. Please take time to review the information in the Welcome Bag after you get parked.

If you arrive before your scheduled arrival date or need to change the number of people in your registration, there are corresponding cost changes that you will need to settle upon arrival. We'll have a Cashier available to expedite your transaction.

Once you're parked, make your way to the Welcome Area. (See hours of operation and map in the program.) At the Welcome Area, you have an opportunity to sign up for your region's meal and other fun activities. There also are information tables displaying the caravans and community service projects.

You need to wear your ribbons at all times on the rally grounds, as this is your official credential throughout the rally and allows you access into all events. We monitor all buildings so only registered attendees are allowed.

What should I sign up for ahead of time?

There are contests that you might want to prepare for before you come, like the Pet Show and Hobby & Arts. We also have a golf tournament that you have to register for ahead of time. Find more information by clicking the link here. You may also be interested in signing up for a tour of the Flaming Gorge (tickets remain for 7/2 after the rally) or a white water rafting trip on Wednesday: see the tours link here.

Getting Ready to Come to the International Rally:

If you have a smart phone or tablet, you may want to download the Grupio app before coming to the rally. This is the best way to stay informed and get last-minute schedule or venue changes. The Grupio app includes the rally schedule, lists of exhibitors, speakers, maps and more. Download Grupio from your app store and search for "Airstream" to find this event.

Water, Sewer Hoses and Power Cords:

Please bring two 25-ft water hoses or longer (usually white or blue), as the utilities are behind the campsites. Bring an additional electric cord and a 50-to-30 amp adapter if your trailer is 30 amp. All sites and Rock Springs are 50 amp

First Timer Ribbon:

In your envelope from Check In, there is a yellow "First Timer" ribbon. Please attach this to your badge (duct tape works really well!) along with your rally ribbon. This yellow ribbon distinguishes you as being there for your first time. Club members enjoy sharing information with other Airstreamers, and especially First Timers. Folks take notice and will be excited to welcome you!

Get involved – Volunteer!

Did you know that an incredible team of volunteers is responsible for most operations of the international rally? Near the Welcome Area tables, you'll find the Volunteer table with available volunteer opportunities and sign-up sheets. Many jobs require just a few hours of your time. Volunteering is a great way to get involved, meet more fun people, and it's fun too! You can also sign up ahead of time using the link <a href="https://example.com/here/beauty-table-ta

Stay updated on rally information:

The rally team arranged the mobile event app Grupio as an additional companion guide for our attendees. The app will contain the most up-to-date schedule of presentations and other rally events, as well as important alerts, reminders and more. Information on downloading the app will be in your Welcome letter, is explained above and will also go out in an email.

We also have our rally Facebook group for those who are social media savvy. Attendees gather here in advance of the event to get to know each other, get to know our exhibitors and speakers, and share the excitement of the rally! Once the event kicks off, the group is also a great place to organize impromptu gatherings, ask last-minute questions, and share information about lost and found items. It's our digital scrapbook! On Facebook, search for "acirally2023" or click here to be taken to our Rally2023 Facebook group. Helpful Hint: Use the magnifying glass icon to type a key word on any question you may have to pull up previous posts/comments about the topics you are wondering about. Use #acirally2023 wherever you post your photos on social!

And, for those who prefer paper maps and program guides, we have you covered, too! Upon your arrival at the rally, we provide you a program book with all the important information

about the rally, including a facility map, daily activities, the presentations schedule and detailed descriptions of each.

First Timers GAM (Get Acquainted Meeting):

We'd like to officially invite you to the *First Timers GAM!* Some of our savvy attendees host this fun event. They are anxious to see you get off to a great start to your week. It takes place at 1:00 PM Sunday in the Exhibit Hall. This social helps bring all First Timers together, giving you the opportunity to socialize and get to know each other while learning a few nuances that can make your rally experience even better. It's a fun informal time we arranged just for you!

Presentations:

With numerous presentations taking place at the same time throughout the rally, you'll have a lot of information to absorb. Most presentation rooms are climate controlled. It's important to wear comfortable clothing and consider bringing a bottle of water along. Some presenters provide hand- outs and some post their handouts on the <u>rally website</u> and on Grupio. It's a good idea to have a pen and pad or tablet along for taking notes. Since it'll be impossible to attend every presentation, partners sometimes choose to "get more bang for their buck" by attending different ones and then sharing what they learned later.

Region and Intra-Club Meals:

Each Region and some Intra-Clubs organize meals at the rally. Signups or ticket sales are available at Welcome. Look for your Region's or special interest's tables.

Socials:

Various groups host organized socials; check the schedule for times and places. Published socials are open to all attendees. Soon, you'll be able to see these functions posted on the mobile event app under Schedule/Events -> Meals/Gatherings. You're welcome to attend whatever social you have an interest in. These socials are a fun way to unwind from your long day, meet new friends and have some fun. They're also informal so come as you are. You may bring your beverage of choice and a snack to share if you like.

Happy Hours:

Many times, informal happy hours spring up with small groups of neighbors in the various parking areas. Don't be surprised if you're invited to participate. You'll enjoy it.

Airstream of Wyoming:
