The next Alabama Airstream Club Rally, **October 2-8, 2023**, will be Tennessee Valley Old Time Fiddlers Rally held in Athens, AL.

This is a maximum effort rally; please make plans to attend this fun, music-filled, festive event. Your registration form should be sent to Mike Hamilton, State Treasurer.

One thing many Air streamers don't plan for is getting sick or injured while traveling and/or needing medical help on the road.

Here are some suggestions to get medical help on the road.

- 1. The CDC recommends that you plan ahead of time. Know where you'll get health care when traveling.
- If you take medications, you should bring them on your trip. In addition, you may pack over-the-counter products like Tylenol, supplements, or vitamins, and first aid supplies. Don't forget bug spray, sunblock.
- 3. Contact your regular medical doctor. He/She may offer online video

appointments or is willing to advise you over the phone.

- 4. Visit a retail clinic. Retail clinics, such as those located in pharmacies, offer basic medical services.
- 5. Use telemedicine service. Some healthcare providers offer telemedicine services, which allow the patient to consult with a doctor remotely.
- 6. **Urgent care clinic**. For saving time, these clinics are faster than the ER room or a doctor's office.
- 7. Local physician. As you travel, you can get a list of doctors and clinics from your insurance company along with their locations that are covered on your insurance plan.
- 8. Ask around for recommendations. Your camp host or RV neighbors may have suggestions or be able to give you the name of a

doctor, clinic, or urgent care facility.

9. It's important that you know when to skip all the above and go directly to the hospital or **call 911**.

# If you have any of these symptoms call 911:

chest pain, shortness of breath, seizures, stroke symptoms, severe allergic reaction, burns, or cuts that won't stop bleeding, confusion or altered mental state, loss of consciousness.

Planning for a trip can add to the enjoyment of traveling. Planning to get help medical help while on the road might not be as much fun, but it will give you peace of mind.

Wherever you go, whatever you do, **travel safely.**
