Back-in sites and Pull-thru sites are \$40 and \$47 per night, respectively. For those of us dry camping there is a dump station for us to use prior to heading home. Fresh water, bathrooms, and showers also provided. Just in case your Airstream is not feeling up to travel, Rose Valley also has casitas you can rent. Let the office know if that interests you.
