Hello, everyone. The rally fee is \$35 Canadian per adult, kids under 18 are free. Canadian members can pay either by eTransfer (preferred to save money) or Paypal; us Americans can use Paypal to pay with a credit card. Paypal will do the conversion for us; when I registered, it worked out to about \$53 USD for Erica and I.

If you haven't already, don't forget to contact the campground, too. Sites are still available! The rally is June 2-6, but you can come early or stay late. 

## How to Sign Up and Pay for an Event Online

Our Treasurer writes:

So, I have to admit that when I first tried to register for an event online I had difficulty navigating to the online event forms. For that reason I thought I would share this information just in case others have had the same experience as me.

- 1. First, log on to <a href="https://airstreamclub.org/">https://airstreamclub.org/</a>
- 2. Click on the EVENTS tab
- 3. A map of the US will be displayed containing pins for all the events for all the Airstream clubs. Just above the map on the right side of the screen is the **Clubs** box. Click on the down arrow to display the list of clubs then scroll down to **Watchung NJ Club**. Clicking on this will cause the map to display only Watchung club events.
- 4. Find the event you wish to sign up for and click on the associated pin.
- 5. A text box giving a brief description of the event will be displayed. Click on the arrow in the orange box that says **More.**
- 6. A new page will be displayed. If a registration form has been created for the event this page will give you two options: online registration or mail-in registration using a download of the form. The online form allows payment via PayPal. If you prefer to pay via check download and print the form, which includes payment instructions. If there is no registration form available yet one will be at a later date.
