Airstreams Aglow: Two fun nights are planned for this event! The first is Tues., Jun 27, 8:30-10pm. Everyone parked in *Boar's Tusk Campground* is invited to light up their Airstreams, inside or out. Folks in other campgrounds are invited to come walk about Boar's Tusk. You'll come across Airstreams Aglow in all kinds of fashion at twilight! Plus, we're holding an acoustic jam session at the Wally Byam Bonfire in Boar's Tusk this evening.

On Thurs., Jun 29, 8:30-10pm, it's the evening for folks parked in *Pilot Butte* and *White Mountain Campgrounds* to stay put; turn your lights on, plug in campsite decorations (inside, outside or both) and let that silver shine! It's a night for glamour shots, meeting friends, & admiring all the Airstreams Aglowing!

Both nights feature a "Lighted Golf Cart/Bike Parade". Any personal golf cart or bike is invited to decorate & parade together through the glowing campgrounds. Parade participants meet at Sweetwater Events west entrance at 8:30pm, then caravan to "Airstream Aglow" events on Tues. & Thurs.

Announcements: Important announcements will be sent as notifications on the mobile Rally Event App (Grupio) and via email.

Badges: All persons attending the rally must wear badges and ribbons (or wristbands for Day Passes) to be admitted to all venues and programs. Write your Big Red Number (BRN) on the back of the ribbon so that it can be returned if lost. New or replacement badges are available for purchase at Welcome. Guest badges can be obtained at the Member Services area in the West Pavilion. We also ask that you wear your badge in town so that local merchants know you are a member of the Airstream Club International.

Bicycle Excursions: Daily bike rides around the Events Complex area are led by Will Kushto beginning on Thursday, June 22. Riders meet at the Breezeway at 7am for a 90minute ride.

Blood Drive: This year ACI is teaming with Vitalant, the Blood Collection Agency serving Wyoming and the nation's largest independent, nonprofit organization focused exclusively on providing lifesaving blood services. This partnership will offer multiple opportunities for Airstreamers to donate at your convenience across four different days, Monday through Thursday. See page 39 for more detail on times and locations. To schedule your appointment, visit donor.Vitalant.org, click on Blood Drive Code button and enter airstream23 to display the Rally site schedule.

Club Store: The Airstream Club store sells only official club items or items receiving endorsement from the Airstream Club. Find them at Booth 52 in the West Pavilion.

Diaper Drive: This year's International Rally attendees will be rallying together to support a Diaper Drive for the United Way! You can support the United Way of Southwest Wyoming's mission of Uniting People, Sharing Resources and Improving Lives in Southwest Wyoming by bringing diapers, any size, brand, or quantity, baby wipes and Depends or by donating online using the link on the rally website. Donations can be dropped off at the Ultimate Airstreams Bunkhouse 8 on the Midway. *Thanks to Ultimate Airstreams for sponsoring our community service project!*

Dog Park: There are two off-leash dog parks located between the Exhibit Hall and Pilot Butte campground and near the Boar's Tusk campground (see map) with separate areas for large and small dogs. Friendly dogs are welcome to romp and play but remember to clean up after them to keep the area nice for everyone.

Exhibitors: Visit the Rally Exhibitor Hall, located in the West Pavilion, to find great deals on Airstream merchandise, parts, accessories, apparel, service appointments, unique finds from artists, and local goods too. They are open Sunday,

June 25, from 9am to 4pm, through Friday, June 30. (Note: Closing early at 2:30pm on Wednesday.)

First Timers' Experience: If this is your first Airstream International Rally, we send you a warm welcome! We will do our best to share information that will make you feel comfortable and involved during your stay. We encourage you to connect to other attendees and event organizers if you have any questions, need any assistance, or just to have more fun. We will let you know how!

First Timers' Get Acquainted Meeting (GAM) is Sunday, June 25th at 1:00 p.m. in the Exhibit Hall: All First Timers are invited to this GAM. This is where experienced members of the club let you know how to navigate the rally so you can get the most of this experience. You will meet lots of other First Timers plus more experienced members who want to help you get connected to the various groups and activities that are available during your stay. Plus, there are treats!

Food and Clothing Drive: Contribute to our annual tradition of providing support to local groups and shelters by donating hats (homemade or store bought), stuffed animals, blankets or throws, women's shelter items, tabs (we cash them in for Ronald McDonald House), food pantry items and pet supplies for cats and dogs. Look for donation table in Welcome to drop off your items.

Food Service: A variety of food trucks will be available beginning Wednesday, June 21, for breakfast, lunch and dinner in the Midway area.

Friendship Center: Meet up with friends in the Exhibit Hall East each evening for games and socializing. This is the perfect place for a game of joker, bridge, gin rummy, or to just sit and chat.

Generator Hours: Quiet generators are allowed in the designated section of the boondocking area. A generator may be used as long as it doesn't create unreasonable noise or disturb other campers. Generators may be run anytime between 7am and 10pm.

GRUPIO Mobile Event App: This is your best way to stay informed and get last minute changes. It includes the rally schedule with updates, lists of exhibitors, speakers, maps and more. Download from your mobile device's app store and search for "Airstream" to find this event. Or type "bit.ly/acirally2023app" in your browser (case sensitive). Password is airstream25.

Ice: An ice vendor will be located on the event center grounds in the Midway area.

Intra-Clubs: The purpose of the intra-clubs is to connect with other members who share your interests. Most of these clubs plan gatherings at the rally. If you are interested in learning more about a particular club, plan to attend their gathering.

Jam Sessions: Join in any of the jam sessions scheduled Sunday through Thursday evenings. Open to musicians and lovers of music of all ages, skill levels and instruments. This nightly get together brings music-loving members of our Airstream community together to jam on some favorite tunes, maybe learn a new one, and enjoy one another's company. Check the schedule for times and locations.

Laundries: Sweetwater Laundry (open 24 hours) has two Rock Springs, WY, locations: 2528 Foothill Blvd and 801 Powerhouse Dr.

Lost and Found: Found items can be turned in to Member Services. Check here for lost items.

Mail Services: Mail and packages are available for pick up at Member Services, West Pavilion, until noon on Friday, June 30. Items are returned to sender if not claimed.

Member Services: Located in West Pavilion, Member Services is your source for all information about the rally, club, and locale. If they don't have the answer to your questions, they have the resources to get the answers.

Parking Stickers: When you arrive, a sticker with a QR code is placed on the front your RV. This is a surface-safe, sticker and will not harm the finish. This sticker must remain on the RV during the rally. The rally uses this for location information and to record pump-outs if applicable.

Pets at the Rally: All pets must be on 6-foot, non-retractable leashes when outside the Airstream. Always clean up after your pet. There are dog parks between the Exhibit Hall and Pilot Butte campground and near the Boar's Tusk campground (see map). Pets are not permitted in the buildings. Service dogs are welcome.

Presentation Evaluations: Please fill out an evaluation after you attend each presentation. Presentation Surveys can be found and filled out by clicking the link under the Resources menu within each session on Grupio. If you need assistance, stop by the Stella's Sisters Intra-Club table in the West Pavilion.

Propane: Propane is available from Larry Macy, Freedom Oilfield Services, 307-922-1081 (cell), email:

Imacy@wyoming.com. Larry comes to the Sweetwater Events Complex.

Pump-out and Water Service: Pump out and water fill services are available to members in the Boondocking areas. Request forms are available at Member Services and you pay at the Cashier. The Sanitation Chair will coordinate with the vendor to arrange the requested services.

Quilting and Fiber Arts: Quilters, sewists, makers, knitters, etc. Bring your latest project to Quilting and Fiber Arts in the Small Hall Building. Quilting and Fiber Arts are held daily during the rally. Check the rally schedule for times.

Rally Office: The rally management office is located in the Exhibit Hall Meeting Room. Entrance is on the south side of the building. Office hours are 9am until 1pm every day of the rally. If you have questions or concerns about the rally, please see one of the rally planning committee members. Please do not go to the Sweetwater Events Complex office.

Restrooms and Showers: Restrooms are located in the Exhibit Hall and Indoor Arena as well as in the campgrounds; see the map for details of locations. Showers are located in the Indoor Arena and in the campgrounds. All facilities are handicap accessible.

SEVERE WEATHER

In case of severe weather, proceed promptly to the Exhibit Hall building. Pets may be taken into the building but be prepared to accommodate their needs. Remember to bring a leash (maximum of 6 feet) for your pet(s).

We are located in **Sweetwater County**. Use your NOAA weather alert radio to monitor for hazardous weather. Some Airstreamers use cell phone apps, such as Storm Shield, Accuweather, Wx Alert USA, Wunderground, The Weather Channel or MyRadar. Receive weather alerts from the Nixle notification system by texting Zip Code **82901** to 888777. To stop the alerts, text STOP to 888777.

Use your best judgment about leaving the Airstream awning out while away from your rig. Unexpected high winds can damage your awnings and your awnings could then also damage other Airstreams while you are away. Secure awnings, flags, and all loose items around your RV.

Suggestion Box: A suggestion box is located at Member Services. Cards are provided for your comments. All suggestions will be read by the Rally Planning Team and taken into consideration for future events.

Transportation: The rally provides shuttle transportation from the camping areas to the rally activities area.

Trash and Recycling: Trash containers will be placed throughout the camping area. Please place your bagged trash in these. Glass, paper, cans and cardboard recycling is available at the Sweetwater Events Complex. Look for containers marked for these items. Please do not place mattresses, furniture, carpet, tires or other large items in the trash receptacles.

Volunteers: Near the Welcome tables, you'll find the Volunteer/Activity Sign-up table with available volunteer opportunities and sign-up sheets. Many jobs require just three hours of your time. Volunteering is a great way to get involved, meet more fun people, and it's fun too!

Wi-Fi: Strong Wi-Fi exists in the main buildings but not in the general parking areas. Cell phone service is very good in the area so members are encouraged to use their cellular phone hot spots or other mobile hot spots, such as a Jetpack or MiFi.

Worship and Reflection Center: Any member may reserve the Worship and Reflection Center located in the Garden Center. To make your reservation, please contact Interfaith Services Chair, Bob Stansbury, at <u>burytone@yahoo.com</u>. Morning Devotions are daily at 7:45am beginning Monday, June 26.

Youth and Children: Our youngest RVers will be treated to programming especially suited to kids ages 4-17. The registration cost you've already paid covers materials for age-appropriate activities surrounding a daily theme at the Junior Streamers Camp that will keep your kid's busy learning, exploring and having fun! Check the daily schedule for times and more information.






