In anticipation of retiring, I began looking for a camper to travel around and see parts of America that I would like to visit and hadn't been to. So in 2009 (I think), I bought the cutest little used 1985 16' Casita... all original. It was so cute that I felt a bit guilty not pulling it with a VW Beetle.

I visited several parts of Texas with that camper... partly just to visit and also to check out places near the gulf coast to retire to (no income tax in Texas). Well, that plan fell apart... Property, and property taxes in Texas were WAY high. And my cute little Casita broke... **totaled**.



So I began a new search for a camper and a place to retire. I went to an RV show in Little Rock and checked out RVs of all kinds... knew that I needed a larger camper than 16'. 


3rd Annual Community Service Rally By: Trent Roberts
