# What is the Saluda Grade?

The Saluda Grade is a portion of the railway owned by the Norfolk Southern Railway. Its claim to fame is that it is the steepest standard-gauge mainline railway grade in all of the U.S. It gains a miraculous 606 feet of elevation in less than just 3 miles in the area between Melrose and Saluda, North Carolina. To put that in perspective, the average maximum gain is just 300 feet.
