



Santa Cruz Redwood RV Resort 4980 Hwy 9, Felton CA. Sept. 6-10

Welcome to Felton in Santa Cruz County. The Wednesday Welcome Social Hour will start at 5:00 pm and afterwards, there will be a catered Pasta dinner with a vegan option available. Dinner will be served at the Clubhouse surrounded by redwoods with the San Lorenzo River running right below.



On Thursday, all are welcome to join Cliff and Joanne for an easy-going 11-mile coastal bike tour of the West side of Santa Cruz including visits to the UCSC Seymour Marine Discovery Center and Wilder Ranch State Park. Free on-street parking is available along Delaware Ave. near the intersection with Natural Bridges Dr. The tour will assemble at the NW corner of that intersection at 10:15 am with bikes and BYO picnic lunches ready to go. This tour is free, but is limited to 18 people, so please sign up on the Jot form/coupon so we can provide an accurate count.

The first stop is the Seymour Center for a 10:30am-12:00 n docent-led hike in the Younger Lagoon Reserve located behind the Center. The next stop is 90-minute visit to Wilder Ranch State Park for a BYO picnic and either a self-guided coastal walk or a docent-guided public tour the historic ranch buildings starting at 1:00 pm. The ranch has an 1840 adobe and Victoria Farmhouse, gardens, and critters on 7,000 coastal acres. It is a wonderful setting to explore. Next, the tour will return to Santa Cruz for a breezy cruise

through Natural Bridges State Park and the spectacular overlooks along the coastal bluffs bike path of West Cliff Drive including a brief stop at Lighthouse Point to watch surfers catch the waves. The tour ends where it began about 4:15pm with time to pack up bikes and return to camp.

For those who are not bike riders, please join Carole and Bob for a 1:00 pm tour and wine tasting at Hallcrest Vineyards. Hallcrest is five minutes away from the camp at 379 Felton Empire Rd. At 5:00 pm, we will re-join at camp for appetizers and social hour. We are on our own for dinner.



On Friday, for those who would like a little hike, please join us on an .8 mile walk through the Henry Cowell Loop Trail. We will meet at the Visitor Center at 10:00 am. Be prepared to experience the majestic beauty of an old-growth coast redwood forest. Those who want a long hike, there are many options, and a map will be provided. Parking is \$10.00, \$9.00 for seniors or free if you have a State Park Pass. We recommend carpooling. It is only about a mile from our campground. At the end of the day, we meet at 5:00 pm for our social hour and appetizers. Dinner will be on our own. We will re-gather for an ice cream social and raffle starting at 7:00 pm at the Clubhouse.



Saturday is a good day to explore the beach, local State Parks, Downtown Santa Cruz, Beach Boardwalk, and Wharf. The Capitola Art and Wine Festival is a big event in Capitola Village this weekend. Santa Cruz County has many interesting activities to choose from and a list will be provided to those who attend this Rally. After a fun-filled day, we will gather for the 5:00 pm social hour and appetizers. Dinner will be a Taco Bar provided by "Cater This". Vegetarian and Vegan meals will be available. After dinner, we will be entertained by the All Shook Up Band who will serenade us through our last evening at the Rally. You are invited to bring your own musical instruments (ukulele, guitar, etc.) to play along with the band. We sure hope you can join us!

- Either directly register online using the jotform link: <https://form.jotform.com/231769310184153> or follow the 'Register for the Rally' link on the webpage (<https://airstreamclub.org/northern-california/rallies-and-events>), or send this form and payment to the registrar at norcalregistrar3854@gmail.com. **It is preferred you register online**, which makes it easier for the Registrar and Treasurer to keep track of rally registrations.
- **You can now choose to pay your rally fee online via Zelle if your bank participates (initiate through App or bank app) or send check directly to Juliet Scheuer this month. (See below)**
- If you pay by check, **make your checks payable to WBCCI/NorCal and mail to Interim NorCal Rally Chair Juliet Scheuer 1025 Pintail Circle, Folsom, CA 95630.**

- **Refund Policy:** Cancellations and/or changes to registration must be received no later than Wednesday of the week prior to the rally, in other words, a week before the start of the rally. Refunds will be available depending on funds recovered in all categories. Parking fees are refunded according to RV park cancellation policy.
