From the VEEP - 2024/25 Rally Survey Results

Thank you to all who responded to our recent survey! We had 30 responses about where you want to go and what you want to do in the next couple of years. Below are the key take-aways from the responses.

The number one reason members didn't come to the Region 4 Rally in Kalamazoo or the Silver on Silver Rally in Traverse City is that the dates didn't work for them.



The preferred time of year for members to rally in and/around Michigan are Spring and Fall (though all seasons received votes).

Interest different types of rallies is strong! All options presented received 16 votes or more. Here is how they finished in order:

- 4. An International Rally to Ontario
- 5. A Boondocking Rally

- 4. Grand Haven
- 5. Traverse City
- 6. Mackinaw City
