





SEEKING SURVEYING SKILLS

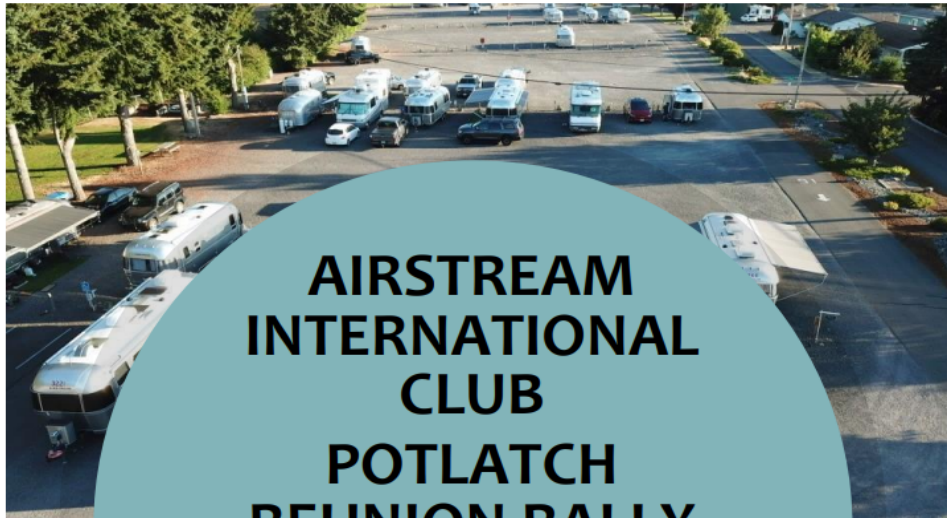
