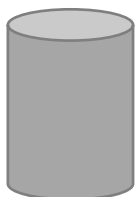
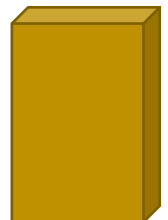

The rally was packed with plenty of things to see and do. There were tours of businesses and museums as well as outdoor activities, craft sessions, a flea market, and a game night.



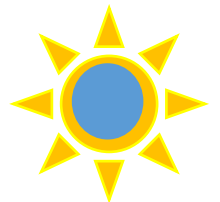
There were some catered meals and great entertainment. We had a great time and met many new friends.
