The rally season is in the fast lane: both the breakout and Jordan Valley rallies are already part of history, and the Caravan to International is here! Don't blink, or you'll miss the rest of the rally season!

A WORD FROM OUR PRESIDENT

On the business side of the club, we've passed changes to our Constitution, and anticipate the bylaws will also be updated! If you have any suggested changes to the bylaws, please contact Charlie Burke.

Regarding our flag color, almost three of four votes cast (20 to 7) were cast in favor of the white flag, so a request was made to International for approval of the flag changes. And just as this newsletter was about to be published, we received notice the request has already been granted! I've priced flags locally, and simply cannot come close to the low-cost flags available through Amazon. I've placed an order to evaluate the quality of the Amazon sourced flag. If the quality is good, flags will be made available for under \$40. If you want a tan flag, now is the time to get it: we have a few that we will sell for \$35 until they are gone.

In addition to changing the color of the Idaho Airstream Club flag, there has been expressed interest in other club-related merchandise. So, the board has approved spending up-front money to purchase small stickers of the club logo (4"X 4"). We have also priced 20 oz Yeti mugs (dark blue) with the club logo etched on them (stainless in color). They were expensive (\$51). If anyone one wants one, you will be able to buy it online (go <u>https://Airstreamclub.org/Idaho</u> and click the "Buy Merchandise" link towards the bottom of the page). If there's any interest in the mug, we will place a one-time order by July 15th, so if you want one, now would be the time to get one. Please note we are now able to accommodate online payments, be it for club gear or for club-related rally fees. To pay online, (assuming you have established your password on International's site), simply navigate to <u>https://AirstreamClub.org/Idaho</u> (this is our new webpage) and scroll down toward the bottom of the page. Click on the action item of choice. You can still pay via check, but checks need to be received from the post office before any deadline. All club merchandise, including the old and new flag, will be available online via the "Buy Merchandise" link.

Notice that the verbiage and pictures on our website have changed. If you have quality pictures or other content you are willing to share with the club, please contact Tony Wilson!

Efforts to establish next year's rallies are under way. If you know of a place the club could rally, please notify me. We are trying to break tradition by entertaining the idea of adding some smaller locations to the rally schedule, even places without facilities. We've even talked about weekday rallies, to secure reservations at more popular locations. Please also consider hosting (or co-hosting) a rally!

DATES:

The official Rally is Friday July 21st through Sunday morning July 23rd.

- Hikes: An optional group activity is an alpine meadow walk at the top of the Tamarack Resort Scenic Lift (\$25 ticket). We'll also lead one other hike (a moderate one), and provide information on more nearby hikes for all abilities.

- We'll provide your campsite # and the phone number for the Idaho Dept of Parks & Rec.
 You must call them by 9/4 to complete your reservation and pay for your site.
- Be sure to sign up for the special Observatory Tour.

A *final rally fee* will be calculated and collected before the rally ends. This per person fee covers expenses not known at the time of the Initial Rally Deposit. It will include shared expenses such as host-provided meals, \$5/person observatory tour fee, etc.

If you cancel less than 1 week before the rally, the Initial Rally Deposit is not refundable.

Idaho State Park camp sites have water and 30 amp electricity, but no sewer hookups. A dump station is available.
