Airstream's Electrical System - Part 3

Knowing the state of charge of your batteries can determine your state of mind. If you are boondocking and do not know how long your batteries will last, this can create a lot of stress and expense. When will the lights stop working? What is worse, the batteries can be damaged if they are discharged too low! This is why you need a battery monitor.



A battery monitor (battery shunt) connects between the negative pole on the battery and your fuse panel. They are easy to install, and depending on the brand you choose there may not be a need for a display panel mounted somewhere in your Airstream. There are many manufacturers that offer a wide range of prices and features. Some offer apps for your phone where you can see a lot of information and history of the state of charge of your batteries. Some shunts can monitor the battery's temperature that will sound an alarm if the batteries start to over-heat.

No matter how basic or sophisticated the battery monitor you choose, they will make your trip more enjoyable when running on batteries and improve the lifespan by not over-depleting them.


Remember, flooded, AMG and GEL batteries should never be depleted below 50% and lithium batteries 80% to 95% depending on the manufacturer.





Chocolate Cobbler

Ingredients:

3/4 cup sugar

1 cup self-rising flour

2 tablespoons cocoa

1/2 cup milk

3 tablespoons melted butter

1 teaspoon vanilla



Instructions:

Mix the above ingredients and spread into a greased 11x7 or 9×13 glass baking dish.

Top Mixture - Mix together and sprinkle evenly on the above mixture.

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup brown sugar

1/4 cup cocoa

Pour 1-1/2 cups hot water gently over all.

DO NOT MIX- just gently pour over all!

Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes. Serve.
