


Sharon Ticer has been working diligently to pull together the rally schedule for next year and should have the list ready to post in next month's newsletter.

Recipe: One Pot Cheeseburger Macaroni

I was looking for some recipes that will please the kids plus warm up tummies when the weather is cold. Cheeseburger macaroni checks both boxes and is easy to make. This recipe is from the Salty Marshmallow.

What you need

- 1 pound ground beef (or turkey)
- 1 tablespoon ketchup
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon hot sauce (optional)
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder

- ½ teaspoon seasoned salt
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon pepper
- 1 ½ cups macaroni
- 3 ½ cups broth or water
- ½ cup sour cream
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese

What you do...

- 1. Cook the ground beef in a large skillet over medium high heat until no longer pink. Drain grease and return meat to the pan.
- 2. Reduce heat to low and add the ketchup, mustard, hot sauce, seasonings, macaroni and broth to the pan and stir well to combine.
- 3. Cover and simmer for 12-15 minutes until macaroni is cooked through.
- 4. Remove pan from heat and stir in the sour cream.
- 5. Return the pan to the warm burner and stir in the shredded cheese until well combined.
