**Airstream Club International (ACI) Rally,
Rock Springs, WY
June 24-30, 2023**

The 66th Airstream Club International Rally at Rock Springs, WY was fabulous. President Eric McHenry reported there were 1192 rigs and 2262 adults, and 71 children. From the Florida Airstream Club there were 22 rigs and 39 people registered. The Sweetwater Event Center was a spacious facility, with full hookups for almost all rigs, comfortable buildings and pavilions for meetings, and three off-leash dog parks. We were spread out in three campgrounds. Good thing we had volunteers to shuttle us around! The weather was a pleasant mid-50's in the morning and 75-85 in the afternoon, except for the storm that arrived a day early and brought wind, rain, and hail (and "waterfront" sites to a few). The White Mountains made a nice backdrop for sunsets, stargazing, and the "Glowing" airstreams.



There were over 200 volunteers who helped make the rally a success, including about 25 from Florida Airstream Club. The first person we saw when we drove into the complex was **Judy Barrett**, cheerfully greeting us and directing us where to go. **Hugh and Elizabeth Geiger** served as Flag Committee Chairs and organized the flag parade for the Opening Ceremonies. **Bill and Pat Shay** coordinated the Coffee Hospitality Committee, arriving early every morning to set up the coffee percolators in the vendor exhibitor area. These included, but are not limited to, The Flaming Gorge Scenic Byway, Red Canyon, Green River, rock formations and dinosaur fossils, White Mountain petroglyphs and wild horse scenic drive, sand dunes, and downtown Rock City murals, breweries, and steak houses.

A variety of seminars were offered on mechanical topics, information technology, cooking, quilting and fiber crafts, jewelry making, history or storytelling, amateur radios, caravan or rally leading, as well as actually backing up Airstreams in a parking lot. For the competitive, there was a pet show, photo contest, and golf tournament. For the social people who like to eat and drink (*isn't that everybody?*), there were region breakfasts or luncheons, wine tasting, food trucks, ice cream socials, and happy hours--both planned with club members and spontaneous with Airstreamers parked next to us. As the campground is smaller in size, the total number of available 'FHU' sites is 20, and there are 10 primitive 'boondocking' sites for those more adventuresome folks! Our rate is \$37/night; a one-time \$5 booking fee plus sales tax and if you're bringing a fur baby, there is a \$1.00/dog pet fee.

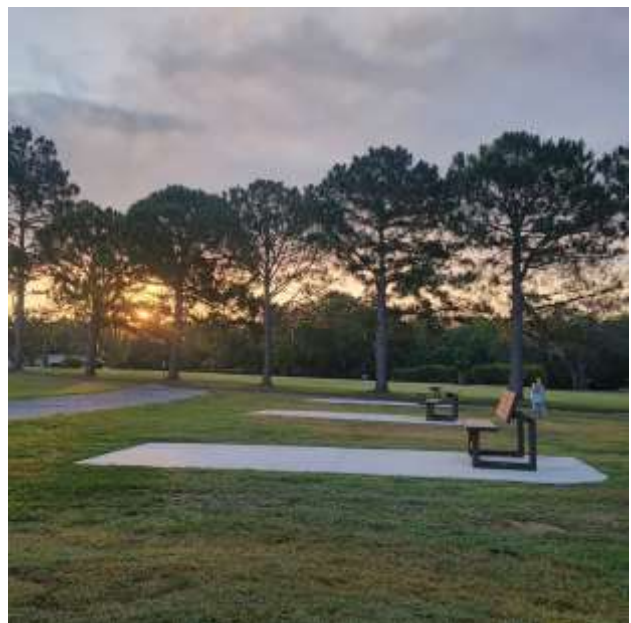
