## **ODDS AND ENDS:**

- 1) Complete an Emergency Form (attached) for each person attending a rally. Place the forms in a sealed envelope with your name and BRN (Big Red Number) on outside of envelope. The envelopes will be given to your hosts and returned to you at the end of the Rally.
- 2) Please consider putting your Big Red Numbers (BRN) on your rig or on a piece of plexiglass that can be placed in front window. The numbers are important if there should be an emergency - the numbers help first responders find your trailer.
- 3) Please take the time to RSVP to the rally hosts after you make your reservations. It is important so they know who will be attending and can plan accordingly
