Christmas Giving Project 2022:

Give a dollar - Plant a Longleaf Pine Tree



The Florida State Park System has been important to all Airstreamers who desire to unplug and enjoy nature. Helping to re-forest Florida with Longleaf Pine is one way we can give back to the Parks that have given us wonderful, lasting memories with our Airstreams.

Longleaf pine forests are essential for native wildlife and for protecting *the Real Florida*. The Florida State Parks Foundation plants a Longleaf Pine for every \$1 donated to the project. Every tree counts!

Plant a Pine is focused on Longleaf Pine which are native to the Southeast and now cover an estimated 3% of their original habitat. They have long been prized for their commercial use in building houses, ships, and railroads and their resin is used for making turpentine. Mature longleaf ecosystems support more than 30 endangered and threatened species, including red-cockaded woodpeckers, gopher tortoises, and indigo snakes. Regular burning to restore their natural rhythms enables longleaf pine to become rich, stable ecosystems. Longleaf pines are fire-adapted and dependent on burning which stabilizes and enriches the soil.

Envelopes will be available for cash or check donations at both the Installation Rally and the Christmas Party. All monies collected will be held by our Treasurer Jan Pfaff and after Dec 3 a check will be sent to the Florida State Parks Foundation from the Big Bend Airstream Club. If unable to attend either activity, think about sending a check to Jan before Dec 3. All checks should be made out to Big Bend Airstream Club. A minimum donation of \$15 is suggested.
