Whitehaven is one of the finest classical revival residential structures in Kentucky.

We're beginners too and can help you get started with learning a few basic chords and stumming a few popular tunes. We practice as a group so there's no reason to be timid. Don't let this chance pass you by. Come and play!

I'll have a tenor ukulele at Paducah Rally for anyone to try out at our sessions. If you have a **guitar or other** stringed instrument, bring it! We'll try a session together and maybe even try a sing-a-long. A few hand percussion instruments will be provided for play by anyone. And, back by popular demand for our adventuresome and spirited, the untamed and unharmonious and unrefined **stumpf fiddle** will be your challenge. (After your attempt, you can indelibly record your name on the fiddle next to the other proud daredevils.)
