
VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

Lori has presented her research and conducted professional training at national and international conferences, holds adjunct faculty appointment at Hazelden Graduate School of Addiction Studies, and developed and implemented training to reduce implicit bias in healthcare providers at the state and national level. She is a member of the American Psychological Association and serves on the Washington State Psychological Association board of trustees. She previously volunteered for King County crisis connections and served on a regional board of a national non-profit focused on youth community involvement. She currently volunteers for the Washington Airstream Club as parliamentarian.
