• Where: Mountaineer Food Bank is located in Gassaway, Braxton County, West Virginia. Braxton County is the geographic center of the State and the Food Bank is just off I-79 exit 62.

Tips and Tricks

AC Gasket Tip from Dave Brett, BRN 1315

One of the joys of owning an older Airstream (ours is an 88 Excella) is getting to replace your air conditioner.

In our case, the air conditioner failed during a heat wave in Tuscon, AZ. There is no getting by when it's 100+ outside so we had a new one installed.

Several things bother me about the new AC. One thing is the fit of the interior cover to the ceiling. The curve of the Airstream ceiling is enough that there are gaps between the edge of the cover and the ceiling. Over time, the air escaping through the gaps creates dirt trails around the cover.

I tried several solutions to make a gasket and it turned out the easiest solution was the best.

I had some automotive vacuum hose on hand and found it was very easy to split one side of the hose with a razor knife. The tubing could then be pushed over the edge of the cover to form the gasket. Vacuum hose is typically black and I'm ok with the appearance of it, but if you prefer a different appearance, you can probably accomplish the same thing with the clear vinyl hose such as found at Home Depot or Lowes.
