2023 International Rally Update: The 66th International Rally, June 24-30 in Rock Springs, Wyoming, is shaping up to be the largest in the past 20 years—with 1200 spots (capacity) already reserved and a waiting list close to 200! Organizers are planning an additional 50-100 spots

in the Boondocking area separated between overflow generator/nongenerator sites. Airstreamers can arrive early at a fee of \$50/night—here's the form for that!

2024 International Rally update: ACI plans to head for Sedalia, Missouri <u>in</u> <u>the fall</u> of 2024! The Club is booking its International Rallies further out than



ever before, and just signed a contract with the Missouri State Fair for its 67th Annual International Rally to begin on October 5, 2024 in Sedalia, Missouri: it's the <u>first time</u> <u>an International Rally will be held in the fall.</u> According to President Eric McHenry, "...we're going to travel through the Midwest when the fall colors are starting to peak and the daytime temperatures won't get so hot as they do oftentimes during our summer rallies." 1400 full-hookup sites will be available!

Region 4 Rally Update: At the regional level, Region 4 will hold its 47th International Rally in Kalamazoo, Michigan running **May 16 – 21** at the
