Located outside Death Valley National Park, this funky little town is a world away from the lights and excitement of Las Vegas.


Tecopa Hot Springs Resort has a basic campground with full hookups. The resort has a lot to offer - incredible private soaking tubs, a labyrinth, beautiful desert vistas, dark skies, and Chef Eric Scott's onsite Steaks & Beer Restaurant.

Tecopa lies in a broad basin that is the watershed of the Amargosa River. This river still flows mainly underground on its spring-fed course out of the Nopah Range. It runs south through Tecopa. The best way to see the river is to make the easy three-mile hike that begins at China Ranch Date Farm. The family-run farm sells wonderful dates, a selection of kitsch, and hike-fueling date-nut muffins and breads.

There are a few delicious restaurants and a brewery in town. The LA Times said that Tecopa is a surprising foodie find. To make reservations, call Tecopa Hot Springs Resort at 760-852-4420.

We spent the weekend at Lake Mead RV resort, enjoying the first weekend of fall. We had a fantastic sunset and as always, great food. This is pumpkin gnocchi with Italian sausage accompanied by Aperol Spritz.





Pumpkin Gnocchi Ingredients



2 (17.5-oz.) packages gnocchi
3 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
4 cloves garlic, minced
1 tbsp. tomato paste
1 1/2 c. low-sodium chicken or vegetable broth
3/4 c. pumpkin puree
1 1/2 tsp. McCormick® Rubbed Sage
Kosher salt
Freshly ground black pepper
2 tbsp. heavy cream
Freshly grated Parmesan, for serving
Finely chopped chives, for serving

Directions

In a large pot of boiling salted water, cook gnocchi per package instructions until al dente. Drain.

In a high-sided large skillet over medium heat, heat oil. Add garlic and cook, stirring, until fragrant, about 1 minute. Add tomato paste and cook, stirring, 1 minute more.

Whisk in chicken broth, pumpkin puree, and sage and bring to a boil. Season with salt and pepper. Reduce heat to mediumlow and simmer, until slightly thickened about 7 minutes.

Stir the gnocchi and heavy cream into the skillet and cook, tossing, until coated, about 2 minutes. Season with salt and pepper.

Remove from the heat and garnish with Parmesan, black pepper, and chives.



Calling all Diesel Drivers

Some of you like challenges and who can blame you. Life is too short not to have them. If you like going into gas stations and maneuvering around the poles, pumps and cars, by all means skip this article. For those who don't mind an occasional challenge and would like the easy route to filling your diesel truck or RV, read on

Open Roads is a discount fuel program open to anyone who purchases diesel fuel, whether it be a diesel pickup truck, RV, or a semi-truck. By joining the program, you will have access to discount diesel prices at specified locations such as Love's, Travel Centers of America Current (T/A), Casey's among others, members are saving on average of 30 to 40 cents per gallon off the pump price. Open Roads are always adding new fueling stations – check them out on Facebook.

There are no signup fees or membership fees to join. There are no long-term contracts to sign and no hidden fees. There is a fee of 10% of the savings per gallon for personal vehicles. For example, if the retail cost is \$3.00 per gallon and our cost is \$2.50 per gallon, the fee will be 5 cents per gallon, or 10% of the 50 cents your saved at the pump. There is a transaction fee of 40 or 65 cents depending on the specified fueling location. This fee is required by Open Roads fuel partners and goes directly to that specific fuel merchant, not Open Roads. Your card is free, but if you should need an additional or replacement card, there is a cost of \$10.00

The App

The Open Roads app will clearly show you all locations in the discount network. If you choose to fuel at a location that is not in-network, there will be a \$1.00 per transaction fee charged.

On the Road...

- Fueling at a truck stop follow the signs for Truckers.
- Pull up to the truck bay.
- Slide your card. Note: some stations may require you to go into the store to slide your card.
- Enter your code (last 4 of your SSN). Enter your fueling station member number if you have one.
- Hit Tractor
- DEF yes or no, it will process and allow you to pump your fuel.
- CAUTION The nozzles pump very quickly so be aware and don't leave your vehicle.
- Once complete, pull your rig forward to the line this allows the trucker behind you to pull in and start filling. You have about 15 minutes to run into the store, use their bathroom, etc.
- Pull out and be on your way.

Are you a Business Owner?

If you are a business looking for a commercial account for your fleet, go to the "Commercial Application" page and you will find the application for that program on there. There is a one-time signup fee for the Commercial Program of \$125.00.



After all these years traveling in our Airstream, I did not think about items we may need to fix or repair the Airstream while on the road. The thought was to call AAA or Good Sam for help; however, that is not always the best or even a choice if you are in the middle of nowhere. Recently, we had a tire issue in Glacier National Park, in the middle of nowhere. A huge thank you to my fellow Airstreamers, Dale and Steve, who changed my trailer tire, for we were hours from the nearest tire dealer or repair shop.

They reminded me to retorque my tires in a few hundred miles. I found out our toolbox did not have one anymore. There is always the thought that if something happens, flat tire or toolbox, I am learning about items to keep in our toolbox. Some I knew about, and some I did not. I have put together a little list that is not inclusive but may help.

- Ladder
- Tape- scotch, duct, electric, alien, painter
- Zip ties
- Extension cords
- Sealer
- Generic toolbox items- hammer, wrench, screwdrivers
- Hitch grease
- Headlamp
- · Measuring tape
- Bubble levels
- Tire changing gear, including Torque wrench (110 psi) for trailer tires
- Air compressor
- Silicone spray
- Rubber sealer and conditioner



The medical toolbox

On our last trip, we needed to obtain medical care while out of state. I have a relatively decent first-aid kit—items like guaze, band-aids, medical glue for cuts, etc. When we sought medical care, we were asked for a list of current medications, current and past medical conditions, i.e., diabetes or COPD, surgeries, and emergency contacts.
