

The Akron Ohio Airstream





Captain's Log, Stardate 10.07.2023: it's difficult to fathom that the 2023 AOAC camping season is almost over . . . with just one last rally scheduled for this Thursday – Sunday (10/12-15) at Pier Lon Campground in Medina. On behalf of the Club's leadership, I'd like to thank our members who planned, hosted and/or attended any of our Airstream rallies in 2023! We'll soon begin the off-season luncheon get-togethers and will "borrow" a few minutes from the November luncheon to plan into 2024. In addition, I'm thinking more of us will be attending the "First Wednesday Breakfasts" once November arrives and our trailers are in storage mode.

Speaking of winter storage, I'll share my routine for winterizing our Airstream. I do add the purple flavor of

RV Antifreeze—I believe it's grape! I first "blow out the water lines" using an air inflation adapter that screws into the city water intake. Using my DeWalt tire inflator, I pressure up the lines to about 45-50



psi and then open valves in the trailer, one by one,



including the toilet. The last valves opened are underneath the fresh water tank, located behind the front axle/wheel assembly on the curb side. Next, I'll empty the hot water tank by removing the plastic valve cap behind

the water tank cover and allow the contents to empty,

soaking my tennis shoes. With our 34-footer a few years ago, I would hastily begin filling the fresh water tank with about 8-9 gallons of antifreeze, only to realize that I forgot to replace the water heater valve cap on



the other side and essentially dump 8 gallons of antifreeze onto the driveway! I would then return to Walmart to secure another 8 gallons! With our 2019 model, there's a hot water tank bypass lever that allows one to leave the tank empty and only fill the water lines with antifreeze—including the all-important low spots in the lines where any remaining water would collect. Inside the coach and under the seating area next to the refrigerator, there's another valve/lever with enough plastic hose to siphon antifreeze right out of the gallon jug into the water lines using the 12-volt water pump.

Mine was originally installed backwards, as were many others according to Airstream Forums, so I reversed the valve and now it works fine. Allowing the run-off antifreeze to fill the drain traps is also advisable. In the spring, I'll fill the freshwater tank with a water/bleach solution and drain everything out to prepare for the new season. Disclaimer: before asking me to assist in your winterizing tasks, please know that just last week, in my attempt to save our daughter, Lesli, some \$\$\$ on an oil

change, I did it myself . . . only to have it towed to our local Audi mechanic because instead of draining the engine oil, I emptied the transmission oil pan! Good grief!
