Thanks to everyone who joined the Region 5 Rally – ‘Autumn Leaves and Horses, Please’ held at the Kentucky Horse Park Campground from Thursday, Sept 13th to Sunday, Sept 17th, 2023.

The attendance for the rally was a total of 64 rigs with 123 people which included many first timers!

The charitable recipient for this year’s rally was Tunnels to Towers. This truly extraordinary organization was created after the tragedy of 9/11 to provide housing and financial assistance to Gold Star and First Responders and their families. Through silent auction items, raffle baskets / items, split the pot drawings and a special raffle of a Yeti personal sized cooler donated by Woodland Airstream, a donation in the amount of \$2,851.00 was made to T2T. Attendees enjoyed live music on Thursday and Friday evenings, a SkyMed seminar and breakfast by Brad Briggs, a Dexter Axle seminar by Glenn Null, a Pet Show hosted by Damon and Erin Beals, tour of Old Friends Horse Park and meet and greet with two of the residents of the Kentucky Horse Park. Recipe Round Up ~ Corn and Tomato Salad

Prep Time: 15 mins

Wait Time: 1 Hour

Cook Time: 10 mins

Total Time: 1 Hour, 25 mins

Servings: 6 (1 scant cup) servings

This simple Corn and Tomato Salad is a delicious side dish that's easy to make and full of fresh flavor!

Ingredients:

- * 2 medium tomatoes, cored, chopped into 1/2" chunks
- * 1 1/4 tsp salt, divided
- * 2 1/2 TB olive oil, divided
- * 5 cups fresh corn kernels, cut off cob preferred (~ 4-5 ears of corn)
- * 2 TB chopped fresh chives
- * 1/2 tsp black pepper
- * 1 1/2 TB white wine vinegar
- * 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
- * 1 oz crumbled Feta cheese



Instructions:

1. Place your chopped tomatoes in mixing bowl and sprinkle with 1/2 tsp of salt. Stir to combine and transfer tomatoes to a colander. Set colander on top of the bowl to let tomatoes drain for 30 mins while completing step two.
2. Drizzle one TB of olive oil into a large skillet or sauté pan and bring over medium-high heat. Once oil is hot, add corn and stir to coat. Cook for 6-7 mins, stirring occasionally, until corn is cooked and has some brown spots throughout.
3. Transfer cooked corn kernels to large mixing bowl and add chopped chives, black pepper, white wine vinegar, remaining 3/4 tsp of salt, and remaining 1 1/2 TB of olive oil. Stir to combine and spread mixture out a bit in the bowl. Allow to cool (about 20 mins).
4. When corn mixture is cooled, add tomatoes from colander and chopped parsley and stir into corn. Allow everything to sit in mixing bowl for another 30 mins to let the flavors incorporate.
5. Stir in the crumbled Feta cheese and serve.

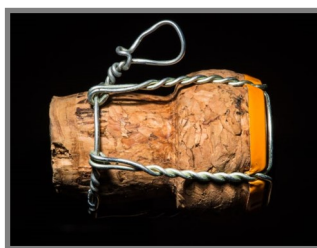
What is it??
