REGION 2 NEWS

October, 2023

At the Fryeburg, Maine, International Rally the voting structure was changed from a delegate format to a system where each member's vote will count in the decision-making process. I want to provide how the membership of Region 2 did in the new voting process. Some of the voting information was provided to me by Eric McHenry.

Highlights:

- * The voting system we use does NOT track or record individual votes the system only tracks if an email voted or not.
- * The percentage calculation used the number of members who voted vs the total number of members in Region 2.
- * Approximately 90% of the membership in Region 2 have valid emails. Therefore, I can assume that those approximately 90% received an electronic ballot for the June 2023 elections.

Region 2 has 962 Big Red Numbers (BRN's), or approximately 1920 voting members. This assumes that each BRN has 2 voting members. The number of reported votes cast from Region 2 for the June 2023 election was 246. That means only 12.6% of the Region voted! Based upon this information, Region 2 had the lowest voting percentage of <u>all</u> WBCCI regions.

I cannot express how important it is for your voice to be heard. Since the number of valid email addresses in Region 2 is somewhat less than 90%, please update/confirm your email address with the record on the WBCCI site.

You can do this 1 of 2 ways.

- 1. Go to https://airstreamclub.org, log into your account and confirm/update your membership information. If you have a partner in your trailer, please add their email information so they will receive any future voting ballots.
- 2. You can also call the WBCCI home office, and they will be glad to confirm/update your email information.

Remember your vote does count. Please exercise the right!

As we move forward, people are either thinking of, or are on the road to, warmer climates, but the business of Region 2 continues. During this time of year, Unit officers are changing, plans for next year's Rallies are either in the books or are in the planning stages. Unit Presidents, please remember to send to WBCCI your Officer's Reporting form.

It has come to my attention that some Units are having joint rallies. I want to encourage this type of activity because there is synergism when a rally event gets to a certain size. Cost factors are distributed over a larger number, allowing for additional activities, friendships from different Units are developed and the volunteer workload is spread over more people. One example is the Rally that the New York Finger Lakes Airstream unit had in August of 2023. They partnered with the Ontario unit. That rally had over 60 trailers. The rally had a rig from as far away as Texas. The 3 NYS units are partnering for a rally in 2024. As you can see, these rallies are not limited to their local units.

Your Region 2 officers have not been 'asleep at the switch'. Plans for the Region 2 Rally are taking shape. So, save the DATE May 2 to May 5, 2024. The location is the Centre County Grange Encampment & Fair. The status is that we are finalizing the contract. What I can tell you at this point is the following:

Sites will have 30AMP hookups and water (dump station is available).

Note Grange Park has HIGH water pressure. Please bring water pressure reducers to avoid water hookup issues!

We will have access to a building with tables and chairs.

We are looking at Catering services and Entertainment options for the Rally.

Pricing/Registration information to follow in the next President newsletters and will be posted on the WBCCI website along with the Grange Encampment & Fair Guidelines.

We will be using JotForm and PayPal for registration and payment.

On the JotForm for the rally there will be an area to volunteer, identify if you have any food limitations/requests, and other inputs for the rally.

We plan to have online registration open for the rally by Jan 1st of 2024.

page from his aunt's recipe book.










Fierce but [somewhat] friendly kite flying competition on the beach, and after the final whistle blew, the coveted driftwood award winners had become clear:
