- Ethics and Grievance: Investigate and assess all grievances or complaints made by members and others according to Article V of the WBCCI Bylaws and make recommendations to the Idaho Club Executive Board.
- Legislative: Study, advise and recommend legislation in the interest of the Idaho Club and its members. Recommend opposition to all legislation which is discriminatory and injurious to the interest of the Idaho Club and its members.
- Social Media: Communicate with Region and International Public Relations Committees. Use Social Media outlets to keep Idaho Club members informed.
