Vernon's Gypsy Traveler

Hi Everyone,



International New Member Dues

International Dues for new members is \$75 for one year. The membership period is on an anniversary year which is based on 12 months from the member's original join date (Example: If member joined on May 1, 2023, the membership is good until May 1, 2024). HQ will collect one year of Local Club dues.

International Renewal Dues

International Dues for renewals is \$75 per year. The majority of our members expiration date is Jan. 1 with the exception of anyone who has joined since July 1, 2021. The renewal process for members will start roughly 120 days before the expiration date (**Sept. 3, 2023**). HQ will send out notifications reminding members it is time to renew. The member MUST be logged into the member-only portal to renew online. ALL MEMBERS ARE NOW ABLE TO LOGIN AND RENEW ONLINE (Primary AND Partner!) HQ will collect one year of Local Club dues.

HQ encourages all local clubs to promote **online** renewals due to the efficiency as well as the time and cost savings for the club. Local Clubs are welcome to do renewals the traditional way, but be advised of the lag time with the postal service. Local clubs are welcome to send funds electronically to HQ. When this happens, please notify <u>membership@airstreamclub.org</u>.

Renewal Forms

Paper renewal forms are available by request only. Members can contact HQ at 937-596-5211 to request a paper renewal form. Members can also select their preference of electronic or paper in the member-only portal. If your Local Club knows of members who would prefer paper renewals, please let HQ know ASAP.

Affiliate & Intra-Club Memberships

HQ is collecting Affiliate and Intra-Club dues for clubs. Members can join online anytime or when they are joining or renewing their membership.

Lifetime Membership

Lifetime Memberships <u>MUST</u> go through the renewal process. This lets HQ know the Lifetime Member is still active and is in good standing with their Local Club. If we do not receive a renewal for a Lifetime Member, they will **NOT** be renewed.

Member Emails

To access your membership dashboard and the member-only benefits, each member must have a valid email address on file with HQ. This also enables members to vote in the election of International officers and amendments to the constitution. If you don't have an email address, it is simple to create a Gmail account with Google or with your Internet provider. Each member needs to have an <u>individual email</u> on file even if you share an email address with your partner. If your current email address is not on file, contact <u>assist@airstreamclub.org</u> or call HQ at 937-596-5211.

Membership Dashboard

Encourage all members to get logged into the <u>Membership Dashboard</u> on AirstreamClub.org. In the portal, members can update their information, see courtesy parking information, membership directory plus member-only benefits. If a member is having trouble getting logged in, please have them contact HQ via email at <u>assist@airstreamclub.org</u> or call 937-596-5211.

Renewals have been simplified to a financial transaction only. If a member needs to update their information, they need to utilize the membership dashboard.

Local Club, Affiliate Dues & Intra-Club Dues

Local Club, Affiliate dues & Intra-Club dues received by HQ will be paid to the Local Club twice a month. Direct Deposit is the preferred method of paying dues.

Auto-Renewal

Auto-Renewal is now available. Members can select this option online anytime or when they are renewing their membership online. We have changed our payment platform. Anyone who signed up for auto renewal prior to July 31 will need to re-enroll in auto renewal due to the payment platform change. We will be notifying the membership of this change.

Transfers

Members are allowed to transfer Home Clubs once per year. Transfers allow members to find a Home Club that best meets their likes and needs. HQ will inform each Home Club of the transfer. During a mid-year transfer, it is between the member and the Home Clubs to work out the Home Club dues portion of the membership.

Published Membership Directory

Any member who wants to be included in the published membership directory must renew before Dec. 31.

Do Not Publish

Members have the option of not having their contact information published in Club's directories. Do not publish means their name(s), region, local club and Big Red Number will be listed without any contact

information. This is to provide a complete listing of members for our members while at the same time respecting the wishes of those members who do not want their contact information published.

Officer Reporting and Communication Form

This form is used to inform HQ who receives membership information as well as to update the database for officer changes. The highest-ranking officer of the Local Club must submit the form. An Officer must notify HQ of any changes by submitting a new club communication form or email the information to <u>membership@airstreamclub.org</u> This form is located at AirstreamClub.org →Current Members→Member Resources→Officer Toolbox→Official Forms or follow this link to the <u>Officer Reporting & Communication Form</u>.

For changes in your communication list, the highest-ranking officer of the group must submit a new officer reporting and communication form. For single changes of officers or the communication list an email can be sent to <u>membership@airstreamclub.org</u> Region officer reporting forms are due to HQ by Aug. 1 each year and local and intra-clubs should be submitted within 30 days of elections or appointments. Dec. 1 is the deadline to include officers in the published membership directory.

<u>990</u>

U.S. based Local Clubs need to file an annual 990. The deadline for filing varies depending on the Local Club, as well as what type of 990. If you are unsure of your Local Club's deadline, please contact HQ at <u>info@airstreamclub.org</u> Regulations have changed, and an officer from the Local Club must be the one to complete the filing. HQ has step-by-step instructions available to help with this.

Local Club Activities

<u>AirstreamClub.org</u> is now the central database for all events. Local Club officers should be working with the Local Club webmaster to get this information posted to <u>AirstreamClub.org</u> If your webmaster is having issues accessing your Local Club information on the site, contact the Information Technology Committee at <u>ITC@airstreamclub.net</u>

Chris O's Ramblings

As many of you know, we completely remodeled/rebuilt our 1972 Sovereign, lovely named Little Girl. I think one of the questions we get asked fairly often is, do you replace axles? The answer is no. Replacing Airstream axles has been added to my "Never doing this again" list. Some examples of things on that list are reroofing a house, blowing insulation into walls and an attic crawl space, and changing oil on cars/trucks. We are also asked for a recommendation of some place that will replace axles. Up until a month ago, I never had a recommendation. Now we do – Crystal Welding in Rogers, MN.

Back story: We blew a tire on the Airstream while traveling to Spearfish SD last August. Long story short, the reason was the shock mount on the front axle on the port side (drivers' side, street side) got bent by some unknown road debris and was rubbing on the inside of the tire. I managed to wail on it with a hammer and got it straightened some, so it was no longer rubbing on the tire, and we completed our trip. Purchased a new tire in Spearfish to replace the mostly shredded one.

Once we got back home, we brought the trailer into Crystal Welding to have the shock mount either repaired or replaced. Got a phone call a couple of hours later telling us our axles were bent and needed to be replaced. Ouch! We believe they were a causality from the Alaska Caravan trip. So, we had them order axles for us. This was Sep 25th. Axles should be in in 2 to 3 weeks, which was good because we were planning on leaving for Texas on Oct 25th.

Those of you that do remodeling projects have probably at some time or other, uttered the words, "while we're at it." Kay and I did the same thing, and asked them about raising the trailer 2 inches. Which they can do with a lift kit they fabricate in the shop. What the heck, it's only money...

Starting about Oct 12th, we started getting antsy since the axles had not arrived yet. They finally came in on Oct 18th, less than a week from our planned departure date. Brought Little Girl back to them to have the axles and lift kit installed. Then of course, more bad news. The axle supplier miss-welded the mounting brackets. They were offset to the left a half inch. We didn't have time to get new axles shipped and installed, so after talking with the techs, we opted to install the axles as is. They assured us many times that the tires would not rub on the frame or skins, and we would never notice the difference in towing. It would mostly be a visual thing if you knew what to look for.

The trailer was finally ready to go and we picked her up on Oct 24th – just one day before we planned to leave. Come to find out, they really didn't like the mounting brackets being off a half inch, so they cut them off and fabricated new mounting brackets with the 2" rise built into the mounting bracket instead of a separate lift kit. They busted their butts making sure we got her back in time! And the work they did was outstanding.

Notice that the top of the blue rims are now visible.



We drove to Texas without any incidents, and she towed just as she did before the new axles (like a dream). There we a couple of driveways in and out of gas stations that I know we would have dragged the rear of the trailer on, but the 2" rise kept that from happening. The biggest difference we noticed is when we stop at a rest area and need to get into the trailer. Before, we could easily climb in without putting the steps down. Now, it's more of a struggle, and opening the steps to we can use the top step makes life easier. She is at Texas Airstream Harbor for the next few months, hibernating and waiting for us to return mid-February. Should be interesting as we will be bringing Nala, our cat, with us as well as Ricky (dog).
