
#### Meet Janis and Todd Buck:

In addition to both coasts, we have spent nights at the nations 1st KOA Campground in Cody, Wyoming and the nation's highest KOA Campground in Cripple Creek, Colorado (10,000 ft above sea level).

Our second Airstream was the 27FBQ Flying Cloud (trips in orange) which we named Chick 2.0. We had it built to order with the



Awning, Solar and Rearview Camera packages. We chose it because we could tow it with our ½ ton GMC pickup which had a max tow package and 1850 lbs. of payload. We also liked that the queen bed was not touching the walls on 3 sides, had ample closet space and the rear panoramic window to take advantage of the views you get backing into RV sites on rivers, lakes and oceans. For additional fulltime comfort, we recently purchased our 3rd Airstream. A 2023 Airstream Classic 30RB to replace Chick 2.0 which we have yet to name. We enjoy the additional square footage, power awning and reclining chairs but are not a fan of the fact that the sound system is not connected to the TV.

Our most memorable trip to date started in August of 2019 when we began our stint as Traveling Utility Inspectors. That trip took 17 months, covered 21,528 miles, took us to both coasts, thru 40 different states and added 22 state capitols to our list. Our favorite campsites experienced so far are Sea and Sand RV Park in Lincoln Beach Oregon which was right on the Pacific Ocean, Lake of the Ozarks State Park and Land Between the Lakes State Park in Kentucky all had sites that backed up to the water. As far as bucket list trips go, we obviously want to complete the Lower 48 Capitol challenge by visiting the remaining 6 State Capitols which will take us to the extreme Northeast. We are also looking forward to the Airstream Club Rally in Sedalia Missouri in October 2024.


# Notes on a few of the THCU activities in 2024:
