### SANITIZING THE FRESH WATER SYSTEM

People ask if it is safe to drink from the freshwater system aboard the Airstream. The answers "Yes if you maintain it."

The entire water system should be sanitized at least once a year, and routinely after a period of storage. The procedure is easy and requires no special tools.

#### STEPS TO SANITIZING THE SYSTEM

Look up your freshwater tank capacity in the Owner's Manual, add 6 gallons for a water heater if your trailer is a 2020 model year or earlier, (add 2 gallons if you have a Classic with the Alde heating system)

- o e.g. (40gal tank + 6gal) x.013 = 0.598 oz. Household Bleach
- Dilute the .0598 oz. Bleach in a jug of water.
- o Pour the bleach water into the freshwater fill & then fill the tank with water.
- When tank is full, turn on the water pump, run each faucet (including shower) until you smell bleach.
  - Be sure to run both hot and cold separately.
    - Water solution should reach all hot & cold pipes.
    - Water solution should fill hot water heater.
  - Let water solution set in system 3-4 hours minimum.
  - Drain system (Open Fresh Water Tank Drain Valve for faster drain
  - Drain the water heater.
  - Fill and then drain the system again.
  - Re-fill the system with water.
  - That's It! You're Done!


