
January 2024



As many of you know, the AIC International Rally 2024 will be in Sedalia, Missouri. It is very exciting to be hosting it in Region 8. My wife, Berta and I, were able to meet with the Advance Team in Sedalia in October.

As the Host region, we are encouraging everyone not only to attend, but also to volunteer.

There are opportunities to help now, just prior to the Rally, and during the Rally. Organizers have suggested several things:

- Write an article about where you live. People will be traveling through your area on the way to the rally. Is there something interesting to visit? Is there a special campground that you would like to recommend?
- Think about a Bus Tour. Is there an interesting or important place within a couple hours of Sedalia that would make a good bus tour?
- Biking on the KATY Trail. Is there someone who would plan and lead a bike ride?
- There are two important volunteer positions that still need to be filled:
 - 1. Table and Chair Coordinator set up and take down
 - 2. Coordinator of Presentation Facilitators technical setup as needed

- Parking volunteers are needed
- **Shuttle drivers** are needed
- Ambassadors are needed. This is a new idea to help people find their way around the large area of Missouri's fabulous State Fair Grounds.
