# Displaying flags on your Airstream



As an Army Retired Command Sergeant Major, and 30 year Police Detective in our Nation's Capitol, I'm always proud to display our Nations colors as well as the great state of Texas flag on my rig. I have a three flag pole mount affixed to my rig. The third flag I display depends upon the event that I'm attending. I fly my Airstream flag for Airstream events and my Army retirement flag for all other events. I am perplexed when members display their U.S. flag at sun down without the flag being illuminated. There is guidance in the WBCCI Blue Book on the proper display of flags on Airstreams while attending Airstream Rallies.

We spent the last four weeks in a self imposed kitchen renovation that has taken some bad turn\$ if you know what I mean. We were super grateful for the provision to have our rig fixed (quickly I might add). We gleefully made it within 4 minutes of the cutoff arrival time of our destination of the beach!

While we weren't expecting the brake pads to go out, it was a good reminder to keep up on our maintenance and upkeep on our Airstream. We were also grateful for the food we had on board. (We normally stock up when we arrive after the fridge is set - IFYKYK). Because we were hooked up to the Airstream during its repair we were able to have a meal and some water at our stop (which was not in walking distance of anything). We've had our fair share of other issues on the road (flat tires, etc) and it pays to be prepared for the little bumps (or brakes) in the road.

In Port Aransas, a RV resort of 1,000 palm trees, heated pool and hot tub eased our mishap. We are looking forward to many Airstream trips, rallies, and less mishaps in 2024! See you on the road!
