Newsletter Chick: AllyEbbers

Although we both grew up on the Texas coast, we somehow ended up in Northeast East Texas. Don (spouse) was a private practitioner dentist in Longview Texas for 35 years. I have worked in a myriad of positions, but the last 10+ years, I was with Governor Perry's office as a regional economic development specialist. My work involved serving as a liaison with 52 counties in Northeast, Deep East, and Southeast Texas, including some work in the Houston area. We lived on Lake Gladewater (north of Tyler) for about 20+ years with our two beloved labrador retrievers, Lagniappe and Flambeaux. Our first lab passed in 2006 and we hunted ducks, doves, pheasant, chukar, geese, and retriever bumpers for most of our combined lab years. For 13 years we traveled with Maggie (our first lab) but quickly ran out of room in the 19 foot 1999 Bambi. We upgraded to a 2006 25 foot Safari and traveled with both of our labbie sisters for 10 years. Don and I retired on exactly the same day to await the arrival of our first granddaughter. After spending most of August/Sept in an RV park near a Houston hospital (think 100 degrees and 100% humidity), we both agreed to sell our trailer, our house, the boat, etc....but as fate would have it, we missed our time in the AS, so we bought the only 25 foot FC in 2015 with two air-conditioners and twin beds in the whole country. We picked it up at the AZ/CA border making the turn-around trip in just 3 days!

We returned to traveling, spending many months on the road and saw much of the western US including the "Mighty Five in Utah." In 2017, we did a few months traveling to the eclipse in WY, Mt Rushmore, the Badlands, Yellowstone and the Grand Tetons. Since 2015, we have seen much of the west and attended our first International Rally in Summer of 2023. Numerous trips to Florida continue to be our "beach fix." One trip to JC for initial issues but those were worked out quickly with a great staff and workmanship. So we picked our present rig because it had two AC and twin beds. My only regret is that we spent 1999-2015 without joining WBCCI because we were both working and only had time for weekend trips close to home and our week of vacation in the mountains. I feel like we missed out making some dear friends and will always regret "that lost time."

We both love educational travel and enjoy the cultural and historical perspective we gain when we travel. I love photography and am seldom without at least two cameras (sunrises are perhaps my favorite followed closely by sunsets, beaches all times of the day, and of course, our 9 year old granddaughter.) Since Don's ocular cancer diagnosis

in 2020, our focus and goals have dramatically shifted and we try to camp in the months between his scans every 3-6 months. We immediately sold our house on the lake and moved to the hill country to be closer to my parents and his oncology physicians who are specialists in the type of cancer that Don has.

Our favorite spot to camp is in rural Colorado in the mountains, preferably near a river as my happy place to "chill." (Pictured on the right). The respite is always welcome after the frenzy "of life."

Our trailer is numbered 8614 for two very landmarked years (married in 1986 and retired in 2014). Our trailer is named for my dad who was nicknamed ACE - he was a pilot in WWII flying B-24's - thus our Flying Cloud is "The Flying Ace." He taught me the love and gift of travel..

Canada "may be" on our bucket list with the AS but the auroras' are definitely on the list!

- Additional information regarding activities, rally fees, and limitations will be published to the attendees as we get them.






THCU Sedalia Bound Caravan (September 26-October 10, 2024)
