Check out time 11:00 AM: We know there is much to see in Northern Arizona, but to allow us to be ready for the next guest, Check-Out time is 11:00 AM. If you need a Late Check-Out, please stop by the Front Desk and we will do everything we can to accommodate you.

Quiet Hours: 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Please help everyone enjoy their visit too by observing the posted guiet hours

Pets are welcome, but must be kept on a leash 6' long or shorter at all times and not be left unattended. We have 2 fantastic off leash pet parks located on either side of the campground to let your pets run free!

Campfires are allowed, however: With our abundant tall pine trees and ever present fire danger, we have to be extra careful in Northern Arizona with campfires and follow the Forest Service imposed fire regulations. Fires are ONLY

ALLOWED in designated fire rings and

please extinguish all fires. Firewood is for

sale at the Front Desk.

Trash Bins are located throughout the campground for your convenience. Please help to keep the campground looking beautiful by picking up your site. In addition, please do not place any hot ashes into the trash cans. If you see any area that needs attention, just let us know at the Front Desk.

Speed limit 4.5MPH, Please help to keep your fellow campers safe by maintaining a speed of less than 5 miles per hour. All vehicles should be driven by licensed drivers at all times within the campground.

Safety: No firearms, bows and arrows, air guns, paint guns or slingshots may be used or carried in the camping area. Alcohol may be consumed in moderation on site by adults of legal age.

ATVs, Off-Road Vehicles, Side-by-**Sides, Etc.** are allowed to travel slowly from your site out to the front of the campground to connect onto local trails. Please avoid riding through other quests sides and there is no "Active" riding in the campground

Pool Rules are Posted. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older. NO LIFEGAURD PROVIDED, swim at your own risk.

Sewer Connections are required by local law to be airtight and hoses elevated off the ground if left connected.

Water is a precious resource in Northern Arizona. All of our water is trucked in, so please help us to conserve by turning off faucets and showers when not in use. Washing of vehicles is prohibited. Please notify the Front Desk if you notice any water leaks. Thank You.

Agua: Todo nuestra agua es transportada en camiones cisterna, así que por favor conserver el agua en grifos y duchas de inflexión cuando no esté en uso. El lavado de vehiculos está prohibido. Por favor notifique a la oficina si usted nota alguna fuga de agua.

Management: Reserves the right to refuse service to anyone; assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries or loss from any cause; and, reserves the right to evict any person(s) without refund for failure to abide by any of the campground rules or policies.
