For the last three or four years, Spirit of Virginia has been utilizing jotform software to create a portal for event signups, club elections, etc... Many thanks to Greg Heuer for his leadership here.

This year we look to improve the ease of use for our members and the connectivity to our club bank account (Truist) by incorporating two commonly used electronic payment apps (Zelle and Venmo) in the jotforms.

If you routinely do your banking on tablet or cellphone, Zelle will be very familiar to you. This is a pure bank-to-bank transaction and neither you nor the club incur any service charge. Almost all banks offer Zelle in their apps (It was created by the banks as a service to their customers.).

Venmo is very popular and commonly app used to transfer funds between friends (e.g. splitting the bill at lunch), paying the guy who cuts your grass, point of sale purchases at stores, restaurants, farmers' markets, etc... The service fee the club incurs is only 1%, less than a credit card. SOV Airstream Club

ROBERT NEWLON AIRPARK, HUNTINGTON, WW

Usually, Scouting Reports are limited to places to stay in Virginia. But we stayed at this **handy** campground twice last year and really enjoyed it. It is located at the Robert Newlon Airpark, a grass runway airport used by small private planes and the local skydiving club.

From Central Virginia, it is a perfect distance for the first night or last night on the road if you are headed to/from the west. It is located a few miles off of I-64 in Huntington, West Virginia, on the Ohio River. The sites are all full hookup, pull-throughs. The management has been expanding the number of sites over the last several years. Besides skydiving, they hold several music concerts/ festivals during the year.

Perhaps the best part, is the on-site restaurant that is open Thursday through Sunday. It is a classic "locals bar", decorated with vintage aeroplane memorabilia, super friendly and surprisingly good seafood. I had a very nice pan-fried trout there this Fall.

So, go ahead and camp under the spotlights at a Cracker Barrell if you must. But you might want to give the Airpark a touch-and-go landing!
