
I've included the links to 2 YouTube videos. One is on BRN's and Rallies and the other is on RV electricity and Lithium batteries.

PRODUCT REVIEW—WEBER TRAVELER GRILL

If you're looking for a portable camping grill, I can recommend the Weber Traveler.

Pros:

- Folds for easier storage and takes up less space in the back of the truck
- Built in wheels to transport around the campsite
- Removable cooking grates for easy cleanup
- Optional griddle inserts for cooking foods like eggs and pancakes
- Ability to use 1lb or 20lb propane tank with an adapter hose

Cons:

- It's a little heavy, about 50 lbs
- It's expensive

I was lucky enough to find this grill on clearance at Walmart last January. You can buy them pretty much anywhere for about \$400. I paid \$199. Had I not found one on sale I probably wouldn't have bought one. I used the grill all last camping season and I really don't have any complaints. It heats up fast and has a pretty even temperature across the entire grilling surface even though it only has one burner.

The grill comes out of the box almost fully assembled, just need to attach the wheels. Two

gilling grates come standard, and you can buy separately, griddle inserts that take the place of the grill grates. I bought mine on Amazon. It's not a genuine Weber accessory, but it was half the cost and fits just fine.

Bottom line: It's a quality grill and I would recommend it. Shop around and chances are you can find a deal on one.


