Maintenance Minute

If you own a newer Classic, you get to enjoy the benefits of 16" tires. The rest of us have 15" wheels with Goodyear Endurance tires from the factory (at least in the last 7-8 years). The Classic now have Michelin (was the LTX, not they are Agilis CC I understand). Tires are one of the most neglected, but most important features of our towing safety.

So we recently upgraded our wheels and tires to 16" on our 25' International.

Don't have a lot of miles to give everyone a good feel for the difference, but the first 100 miles are very positive since 50 of it was in the rain.

The wheels were ordered from Discount Tire and they are the same SenDel brand wheels that Airstream uses. We chose a slightly different look that the Classic wheel. The tires are Michelin LT225/75 R16 Agilis Cross Climates. We ordered them from Michelin on the Airstream Club discount. Ordering tires on the club discount saved over \$400, so it is a very good deal and I would encourage everyone to use that discount with Michelin. They have most of the tires you need for your tow vehicle as well. Discount Tire will mount and balance them for the sale \$22 they charge for their own tires.
