Maintenance Minute

Are you using a ½ ton truck to pull your rig or do you notice that your tow vehicle (even a ¾ or 1 ton) sags a bit in the back? It is a problem many of us face. For about a year now we have tried a product called the Road Active Suspension for my F-150. This system is essentially a coil spring that fits over the leaf springs on your truck (sorry only works with leaf spring TVs). You can adjust the length of the springs to give you the ride and height you want.

The manufacturer claim the springs also help with ride stability. I have noticed some improvement there with no payload in the bed. However, we have ours set up with the heavy-duty setting for the 25 foot International and it did reduce our sag but about 1.5".



You can read more about this product at <u>www.activesuspension.com</u>. This is a cheaper solution than air bags and new leaf springs if you are trying to control rear end sag and it is easy to install. One person can do it in less than an hour if you are even a little bit mechanical.

We stayed at North Toledo Bend State Park not far from Many, LA earlier this month. This is a very nice Louisiana State Park at the south end of Toledo Bend Reservoir. Believe it or not, only 3 of the 60 spaces were occupied.

The park is being refurbished and the campsites are mostly done. They are level side-to-side, but do have some grade front-to-back. All sites have water and electric (30 and 50A), but no sewers.

When the park is finished with all the projects, there will be 12 miles of hiking trails and 36 holes of Frisbee golf through the woods. This park already has a very nice swimming pool (yes a pool) and plenty of shore and dock fishing. If you cannot disconnect from the world, they also have park-wide Wi-Fi (although it was not working on our trip). This could be a fantastic rally site for ETLU!
