Maintenance Minute

Do you have some rust on your frame or hitch? It is always a good practice to do a little touch up every year. On our Airstream, we take a wire brush to any rust on the frame and then follow that up with a wet rag and a dry towel. Then we hit that spot with some Krylon or Rust-Oleum flat black spray paint.



Make sure you tape off or use some cardboard to prevent overspray onto something shiny (you can get it off with Goof Off! if you happen to happen to make a mistake). This simple process can keep your frame and hitch rust free and make your rig look new year after year. Do not forget to check for rust under your propane tanks.

No volunteers this month but we have a couple very interesting Ladies that are amazing Airstreamers that need to volunteer...Karen and Charlotte where are you...?


East Texas Lakes Pet Profile
