### Maintenance Minute

It is getting warm again and that means we likely need to be able to fire up the AC units. While these units are very reliable, the do need some maintenance. Here are a couple things you can do yourself:

- 1. Clean the return air filters. Dirty filers can restrict air flow and cut down on the cooling efficiency of your unit.
- 2. If you feel safe on stop of your Airstream, you can remove the shroud and clean the condenser coils. Over the winter who know what could have built a nest up there.
- 3. Use a long tubing brush and make sure your condensate line is clean so your unit can drain properly. For most Airstreams, there is a drain located in the road-side wheel well. This is the brush that we use to clean the tube:

It is 7 feet long and will reach close to the top of the unit from the end. It is less than \$8 on Amazon. You may also need to check those lines near the coils when you remove the return air vents for cleaning. Just examine the line for dirt and debris.
