## **IDAHO AIRSTREAM CLUB Pet Policy**

All pets must be managed in a way that does not impose risk to or unwanted interference/interaction with other campers. This means they are to be managed on a leash, carried, or otherwise restrained to eliminate any unwanted contact with others (both people and other pets). Always check collars, harnesses, and leashes and any other hardware used to ensure they fit correctly and are working properly. A size appropriate pet containment system can be used at the campsite. Pets are not permitted in the buildings or in the vicinity of outside dining areas during a meal except for working service animals. Working Service animals are defined by the ADA as an animal that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for a person with a disability. Well-mannered dogs are welcome to play and exercise in designated dog parks. Make sure your pet has an ID tag. Pet owners are required to bag dog droppings and dispose of them in an appropriate place. Owners, ensure you are following specific campground policies.

The pet owner is also responsible for the pets wellbeing, and responsibility for any pet injury: the Club is not responsible for the care or wellbeing of the pet.

All liability resulting in non-compliance of this Policy is the responsibility of the pet owner.
