We have one spot available for the April eclipse rally. Thank you to the Greens and Micheks for hosting this event. They are working on the itinerary which will be sent out to the folks going.

Speaking of hosting a rally, we need a couple of volunteers to host the September Labor day rally in Moody, TX at Mother Neff State Park. The dates are Aug 29-Sep 2, 2024. Moody is located between Waco and Temple. We need someone to take the lead on the itinerary for this weekend. We already have a couple of group activities lined up to add to the itinerary. I also need to get a head count for members attending so I can get the park reservation completed. The deadline for attending this rally is March 27th. Others are welcome to join the rally after March 27th but they will be on their own for finding a campground site. We are also looking for hosts for the 2024 international caravan and November installation rally. Please volunteer; these rallies need volunteers to make it a success!
