Recipe Round Up ~ Loaded Potato Bites

Think of this finger food as mini loaded baked potatoes. Peewee potatoes are boiled, smashed, and roasted until crispy and golden, then finished with all your favorite toppings. Perfect for that Get Together!

Prep Time: 35 mins Total Time: 1 hr 15 mins Servings: 8

Ingredients

- © 2 pounds multicolored peewee potatoes
- So Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper
- \$ 1 container (16 oz) sour cream
- § 6 scallions, finely chopped (1 cup), plus more for garnish
- \$\ 12 \text{ oz bacon, cooked and crumbled (1 \frac{1}{2} \text{ cups)}

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees with racks in upper and lower thirds. Place potatoes in a saucepan; cover with 2 inches cold water. Season generously with salt and bring to a boil, then reduce heat to simmer and cook until a knife pierces potatoes easily, 10 to 12 mins. Drain; let cool 10 mins.
- 2. Drizzle each of 2 rimmed baking sheets with 2 TB oil. Arrange potatoes on sheets, tossing to coat; lightly crush each with heel of your hand or back of spatula to about 1/2 inch thick. Season with salt and pepper; roast, flipping halfway through, until golden and crisp, 30 to 35 mins. Use immediately.
- 3. Meanwhile, in a medium bowl, combine sour cream, cheese, scallions, and bacon; season with salt and pepper. Top each potato with 1 to 2 teaspoons sour-cream mixture. Garnish with more scallions.
