There will be volunteer opportunities on Thursday May 29th and Friday May 30th from 9:00-Noon and 1:00-4:00 (You are free to work as many or few shifts as you like, taking a break during a shift as you may need.) Campground: Groveland Oaks County Park Campground, 14555 Dixie Highway, Holly, MI 48442. This campground is about 20 minutes from the Food Bank. A covered pavilion and a couple firepits are at each group site. Fill up with water when you get to the campground and empty your tanks. 30 Amp power, only, provided for each rig. Rally fee of \$100/rig gets you your site from Wednesday-Tuesday and lunch, at the Food Bank, if you decide to work both the morning and afternoon shifts.
