

Got a Little Help from Our Friends

Saturday evening, November 11, 2023, at the Paso Robles Rally.

It took two retired fire fighters, an engineer, a cartographer, their collective tools, and one "high-wire gymnast" to rescue our two dogs accidentally locked inside our trailer. We hadn't taken our keys with us to the potluck dinner because we didn't lock the door as we left our unit ...no worries, or so we thought.

But when we returned from the potluck, we discovered the door had locked itself! Once we realized our mistake, it took a lot of time (about two hours, in the dark), a lot of hands and hearts (four brave men working to open a side window and a mob of supportive folks keeping our spirits up), a lot of tools (too many to list), and a few tears (Mary couldn't help herself).

Gary Mellinger, Paul Nelson, and Glenn Gray worked diligently to safely and carefully pry open the window latches so that Sweetie (our white dog with fluffy mohawk) could be rescued, and so Linda Dynes



(aforementioned "gymnast") could be hoisted in through the window to unlock the door from the inside. Cooper (our other dog) apparently slept through the whole thing. David and several other folks provided a light-source so the "men at work" wouldn't cut off fingers or hands while they worked. Mary reported that it was the sight of Linda's legs disappearing into the trailer that made her cry. Fortunately, Deborah was there to make her laugh.

LESSON LEARNED: Always have a set of trailer keys on your person when you close the trailer door because—what we didn't know then but do know now is: the trailer latch can sneak its way over into locked position even when gently closing the door.



The other thing we learned (again) is that people (especially rally people) are wonderful and can be trusted to help and support us when we need help. Many, many thanks to all those kind souls who showed up with their skills and their positivity to rescue not only our dogs but us as well!






