Registration

Rally registration will take place online via the Oregon Airstream Club website starting in January. Members will be emailed in advance with date and time details on when 2024 rally general registrations will open.

A 3-day registration process will be used.

- Day-1: hosts/co-hosts will register for their own rallies
- Day-2: hosts/co-hosts will register for a “thank you” rally
- Day-3: general registration begins

Complete registration schedules and instructions will be sent by email several days in advance.

- Rallies will be displayed in date order
- Click on any rally to view event web page
- When registration is open a “Register Online Here” button will appear
- Complete the online registration form including type of payment. You’ll have the option to pay by credit card (via PayPal) or by check.

Preferred payment method is PayPal. A PayPal account is not required. If you pay for your registrations by check, please mail it directly to the OAC treasurer (Stacey Rovinelli, 13606 NW 42nd Ave, Vancouver, WA, 98685), not the rally host. After you register online, you will be able to pay for multiple rallies with one check. Enclose a note with your check detailing your rally registrations.

We will have a few rallies that will be confirmed and booked after the printed version of the rally handbook is distributed. Members will receive email notification with the details for these rallies via email and these rallies will be added to the online version of the Rally Handbook and to the website for registration. The same three-day rally registration process will be used.

Some rallies are very popular and fill quickly so don’t delay. If the rally you want is full, please contact the host and ask to be placed on the waitlist. Often people on the waitlist secure spots, so don’t be discouraged. We have provided the phone number and email of each rally host. Feel free to reach out to them with questions or concerns regarding their rally.

Cancellation Policy

We get it, life happens and things come up. For greatest clarity, here is the OAC rally cancellation policy.

If you cancel your registration for a rally for any reason and your cancellation causes OAC to incur any cost (full or partial), you will be responsible for paying that cost, and any associated fees.

Each rally host knows the specific cancellation policy for each rally venue, and they will coordinate with our rally coordinator and treasurer to assist you in the event you need to cancel.

If you need to cancel, please do so as soon as possible so the rally host can work with those on the waitlist to

fill your spot. Please don't give your spot to someone else on your own, as there are other members on the waitlist with priority for registering for that rally and the rally host will coordinate.

All refunds are subject to rally venue cancellation policies and fees, administrative fees, and a \$5 OAC cancellation fee. Our treasurer will be in contact with you for any refund.

Meals and Food

We've learned a lot having lived through a global pandemic. How we approach meals and food at rallies has changed as a result. Hosted meals are completely optional.

The type and number of meals, if any, to be made available is decided by the rally host. Each host will decide on meals and prices for their meals. **Meal costs are not included in your rally registration fee.** Most often, hosts decide any rally meal plan closer to the rally date and you will hear from them directly with that information.

Participation in meals is completely optional and any meal cost will be defined by the rally host. If you participate in any meals offered by your host, you will need to pay your host directly.

Rally Description:	<p>We will be camping at Stub Stewart State Park just 34 miles west of Portland. Stub Stewart offers a variety of camping opportunities and boundless trails for hiking and mountain biking. Just east of Hilltop are two mountain-style disc golf courses. The nine-hole course is beginner-friendly while the 18-hole course challenges intermediate and advanced players. Next door is the Discovery Depot, where information awaits on the area's flora, fauna, and park history.</p> <p>Nearly 30 miles of trails wind through the park's 1,800 acres, many with names recalling the area's logging history. The park also boasts some of the best mountain bike trail riding in the state parks system, with 15 miles of trails for all skill levels. The paved 21-mile Banks-Vernonia State Trail also passes through the park and is popular for walking, biking and horseback riding. Park trails connect to the Banks-Vernonia State Trail, or park at any of its six trailheads.</p>
