News from the Park

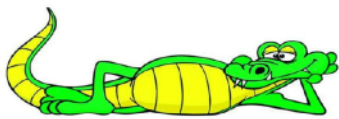

Recipe of the Month



Sausage and Potato Soup

Ingredients

- 1 pound country sausage
- 1 medium yellow onion , diced
- 3 cups low sodium chicken broth
- 2 cups half and half
- 2 pounds russet potatoes , diced
- 4 carrots sliced into rings
- 8 ounces of fresh kale
- 1 cup sour cream
- salt and pepper to taste
- 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese (optional)

Instructions

- Heat a large soup pot over medium heat brown sausage and onion, stirring occasionally. Drain and set aside sausage and onions.
- Return pot to medium-high heat add potatoes and carrots. Add chicken broth, half and half and bring to a simmer. Reduce the heat to medium-low cook until potatoes are fork tender. (About 15 minutes)
- Bring heat up to medium -high and stir in sour cream, cooked sausage & onions and 8 ounces of fresh kale. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Turn heat back down too low.
- Serve hot topped with cheese, and an additional dollop of sour cream.
- This is a great Cold weather meal just add a slice of warm sourdough bread.

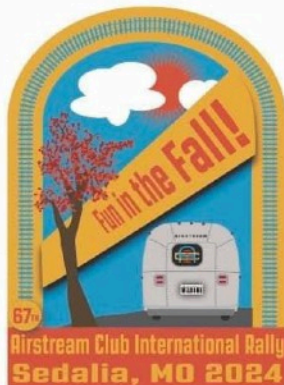
