NOTE: All electric power at the rally will be 30-AMP; please bring an adapter, if needed. Additionally you may want to bring extra water hoses, sewer hose extensions and water hose Y-adapters. Camping includes water and electric. Please plan on arriving to the rally with empty gray and black tank. The Meadow Event Park facility does provide access to multiple dump station locations for your "blue-boy" portable sewer container (should you own one) for emptying throughout the rally.

We will periodically provide you with updates for the rally via email leading up to the event dates. Stay tuned for additional info about the detailed agenda.

We are pleased to offer our club members this first post-Memorial Day camping opportunity in the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains.

If you have never been there, Sherando Lake Recreation Area is a CCC-era recreation and camping facility administered by the US

Forest Service (USDA). It is in the George Washington Forest between Stuarts Draft and Wintergreen. We believe you will find it a refreshing break from the usual commercial campground fare. More information here:

The club reserved 13 spots in very pleasant Loop C. Electricity (30/50 Amp) is provided, but there is no on-site water or sewer. There are three water stanchions on the short loop, but come with your fresh water tank full and waste tanks empty. There is, of course, a dump station available. The updated Bath/Shower house is in easy reach of all sites (say 100 yards).

A rally fee of \$20/adult will cover expenses for provided meals.
