# President's Message

Why we love Boondocking

Boondocking, which includes dry camping in primitive campgrounds, camping on remote BLM land, or just finding a convenient spot to spend the night, appeals to many but isn't as widely practiced among Airstreamers.

Several years ago, I was talking to a senior executive at Airstream and asked them why many of their ads showed trailers boondocking in remote locations. Still, none of their trailers were really designed for boondocking. His answer was, "That's just marketing – most of our owners only want to camp in RV parks." Since then, they have introduced some new models designed for boondocking, including the new Tradewind.



We love going to Rallies and camping with our friends, but we don't enjoy paying \$100 a night to be packed into a rundown RV park with hundreds of people we don't know. We would always choose camping in a remote spot with no hookups or people.

We love the allure of adventure and exploration and find solace and exhilaration in wild natural areas. We prefer to be near hiking or biking trails and mountains we can explore. I also love photographing the night sky and seeking out dark skies without lights from other trailers.



Beyond the intangible joys of freedom, solitude, and beauty, boondocking also offers a host of practical benefits for Airstreamers. Foremost among these is the significant cost savings associated with off-grid camping. By eschewing traditional campgrounds with their nightly fees, boondockers can stretch their travel budget further and indulge in longer journeys without breaking the bank.

If you are interested in learning more about Boondocking and talking to people with a lot of experience, we recommend attending our Maintenance Rally in May. # New Rally Registration Information by Steve Libhart

The Colorado Airstream Club has grown exponentially over the past few years to nearly 600 members...something to be very proud of!

Your board recognized the need to increase the number of rallies to give as many people the opportunity to attend rallies as possible. Also, campground fees have increased yearly, and many facilities now require full payment several months in advance. This causes an increased draw on the club's cash flow months before the actual rallies begin.



To help coordinate more rallies and increase cash flow for the club, it has become necessary to revamp our registration processes.

Formerly, when registering, the member would pay directly via the JotForm. While this served the club well for many years, problems began to present themselves, with slow payments from PayPal being made into our bank account and a considerable amount of time reconciling between our bank and PayPal every month.

The new registration flow is a two-step process, and our payments are made directly into the bank account within two business days. This helps create the cash flow to accommodate the increased fees and advanced payments to the various campgrounds.

When you register, the first step is to complete a JotForm just as you have done in the past. You will no longer pay from within the JotForm and will receive an invoice from the Colorado Airstream Club shortly after submitting your Jotform registration.

The second step will be to watch your email for the invoice, click on view and pay, and fill in your payment information; it's that simple, and you will have an option of 5 ways to pay the invoice. After remitting your payment, you will receive a receipt via email.

We spent February and early March testing this new system and launched it recently with two rallies. Everything flowed seamlessly!

Here are some questions we received:

- Once I complete the first registration step, will I be registered before making the payment? Yes, once you register, your space at the rally will be reserved. However, you must watch for the invoice and pay it to complete your registration process.
- How long will it take for me to receive my invoice after registering? Usually, it takes only a few minutes, but the invoice could arrive a few hours later, depending on the time of day you register. As an example, if you were to register in the evening, your invoice would more than likely arrive in your mailbox by the next morning.
- Will I receive a receipt? A receipt will be emailed to you immediately after you pay your invoice.
- If I have any other questions regarding this new registration process, who can I contact? Contact Linda at <u>treasurer@coloradoac.org</u> We are working hard behind the scenes to help you transition to the new registration process and are here to help!
