# "Fun on the Farm" Rally, Greenville IL

#### **RV Sites**

Our RV sites are located on the grounds of the American Farm Heritage Museum (americanfarmheritagemuseum.com). COST is \$20 per night. Cost for the full rally (Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights, June 6 – 9, departing on Monday, June 10) would be \$80. Arrival 1:00 PM or later; Depart by 1:00 PM.

Sites have ELECTRIC HOOK-UPs only. There are NO WATER OR SEWER HOOK-UPS. There is NO DUMP STATION. There are bathrooms a short distance from the RV sites. THERE IS NO SHOWER HOUSE. Sites do not have campfire rings.

There is no camp office. As you enter the museum grounds, turn left at the second road. On your right, you will see 5 numbered pedestals in a row, near to the Pavilion; each pedestal serves two RVs. Four of the five pedestals are 30 AMP on both sides; the remaining pedestal has both a 30 AMP and a 50 AMP plug-in. All camp sites are back-in to a line of trees and are on level grass. Tow vehicle parking is behind the tree line. On arrival, Jim will be on-hand to assign and guide you into your site. NOTE: Due to the shared pedestal, five rigs will need to park curbside to the pedestal. This will require running your electric cord <u>underneath</u> your trailer for electric hook-up.

THESE 10 SITES WILL BE HELD FOR THE FIRST 10 RVers WHO MAKE THEIR RESERVATIONS AND PAY Kathy. Payments can be made in person (cash or check) at the April Bluegrass Flash Rally in Colchester OR checks can be mailed to Kathy Ceryes, 7600 Baxter Drive, Belleville IL 62223. Please call or text Kathy that you are mailing your check at 618-444-5101.

AFTER the 10 sites are filled, there are still 2 additional 50 AMP sites and 2 additional 30 AMP sites on the museum grounds that can be used by us, if needed.

For those who wish to attend the Rally but prefer an RV site with more amenities, there are two RV parks located in Mulberry Grove IL, about 9 miles /10-12 minutes northwest of the American Farm Heritage Museum. Cedarbrook Campground and RV Park (cedarbrook-rvpark.com, 618-326-8865) is accepting reservations now, and Timber Trails Campground (timbertrails.itgo.com, 618-326-8264) will reopen and begin taking reservations April 15. Cedarbrook is closest to I-70.

#### Pets

Pets are allowed but MUST be on a leash. The park requires that you clean up after your pet.

#### Pavilion and Gazebo

We have reserved the on-site outdoor Pavilion for all days of the rally. It can be used for any of our scheduled activities: potluck meals, announcements, games, entertainment, uke practice, and the morning "coffee klatch." Coffee will be available in the Pavilion Friday, Saturday, and Sunday mornings and during evenings, if anyone would want to brew a batch. A nearby smaller metal gazebo is also available for our use. It has no overhead lights or electricity.

### Bike Riding

Plenty of room for bike-riding on the grass and chat roads and parking lot.

### **Planned Rally Activities**

The Rally will begin with Thursday's Potluck Dinner at 5:30. Each evening at 7:00 PM we will have a light-hearted fun activity with a farm theme, including sing-alongs with our club's ukelele players (farm songs, of course ②).

On Friday and Saturday, we will tour a dairy farm and milk processing facility, as well as a specialty beef cattle farm / dairy farm with a cheese processing facility. We will visit the American Farm Heritage Museum and grounds, including a Model Train Show special event, open to the public that day—This rally is not ALL about farming!--and we'll visit the DeMoulin (non-farm) Museum in downtown Greenville. We'll eat lunches as a group in Greenville and Pocahontas.

On Sunday, we'll have a 9:30 Potluck Breakfast, and at 1:00 PM we will tour a Honeybee farm. Our closing activity 7:00 PM Sunday evening will be sharing our Farm Memories with the group.

Cost for touring the three farms and two museums is \$23 per person, payable to Kathy Ceryes prior to the Rally.

Monday morning has no planned activities. Depart by 1:00 PM.
